Objective:

Description:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of KL University organized an Orientation Program for newly enrolled volunteers for the academic year on Wednesday, 10th September 2025, informed Dr. P. 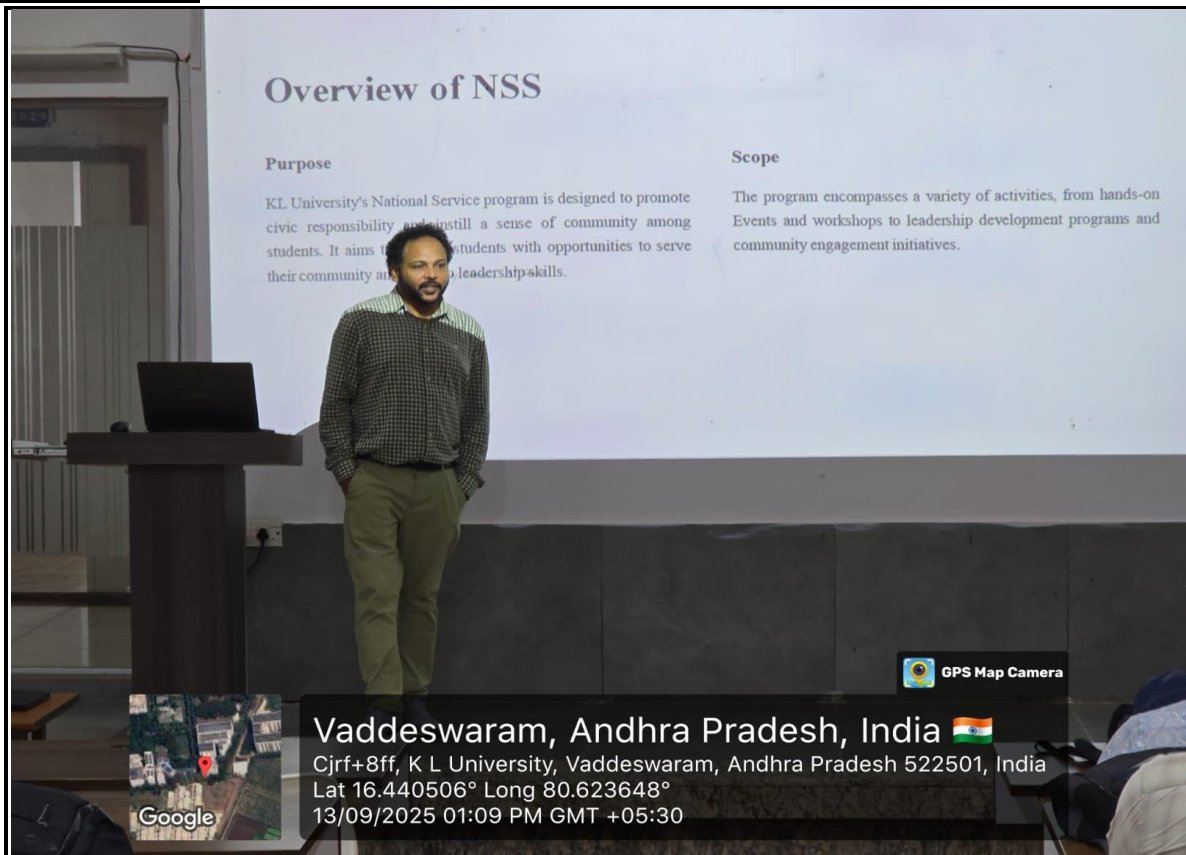
Impact on Society:
