Objective:

The objective of Training the Public on Primary Medical Care on World First Aid Day is to equip individuals with essential knowledge and skills to respond effectively during medical emergencies. It aims to create awareness about basic first aid techniques that can save lives before professional medical help arrives. The program encourages community participation and builds confidence in handling accidents, injuries, or sudden health issues. It also emphasizes the importance of timely intervention to reduce complications and fatalities. Ultimately, it fosters a safer and more prepared society capable of providing immediate care in critical situations.

Description:

Under the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of KL University organized a training program on primary medical care for the public on Friday, 19th September 2025 at Revendrapadu village, Duggirala Mandal, conducted by CSE-4 division NSS volunteers, as stated by the Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad.

He mentioned that in the present times, sudden heart attacks can occur regardless of age, and by providing basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) without panic, bystanders can help save lives until the patient reaches a hospital. Similarly, awareness was provided on how to respond if farmers are bitten by snakes while working in the fields, by immobilizing the affected area with a cloth and taking them to the hospital as quickly as possible. The program also covered first aid measures for road accidents, fire accidents, and other emergencies, as well as the essential medical tools and supplies to keep at home, explained NSS Programme Coordinator Dr. P. Sreekanth Reddy.

The program was coordinated by Mr. P. Suresh, and the volunteers were felicitated by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. Pardhasaradhi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkatram, Dr. K. Rajashekar Rao, Dean of Student Affairs advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, and Programme Officer Mr. G. Mohan Rao, among others.

Outcome:

The primary medical care training organized by KL University NSS enhanced public awareness on emergency first aid and CPR techniques, enabling participants to act confidently during sudden health crises like heart attacks. Farmers and villagers learned how to handle snake bites, road accidents, and fire-related

emergencies safely. Participants gained knowledge about essential home medical supplies and basic treatment measures. The event empowered volunteers and the community to respond promptly in emergencies, potentially saving lives. Overall, it strengthened the community's preparedness and health resilience in Duggirala Mandal.

Impact on Society:

The event significantly enhanced community health awareness, equipping villagers with crucial skills to handle emergencies. It reduced panic and hesitation during sudden accidents or medical crises by teaching basic first aid and CPR. Farmers and local residents became more confident in safeguarding lives, including their own and others'. By involving NSS volunteers, the program strengthened the culture of volunteerism and social responsibility. Overall, it fostered a safer and more prepared society in Revendrapadu village and surrounding areas.
