

Objective:

The objective of creating awareness on education for out-of-school children on International Literacy Day is to highlight the importance of literacy and learning for every child. It aims to motivate children who are not enrolled in schools to join educational programs. The initiative seeks to inform communities about the long-term benefits of education for personal and societal development. It encourages active participation from families and local stakeholders in supporting children's education. Overall, the programme fosters a culture of learning and helps reduce illiteracy in the community.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of KL University, under the Sakshar Bharat Abhiyan, organized awareness on education for out-of-school children on International Literacy Day on Friday at Atmakur village in Mangalagiri Mandal, led by the Department of Arts NSS Unit. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that literacy is not only a tool to transform an individual's life but also a powerful means to change society. He emphasized that education paves the way for economic self-reliance, women's empowerment, and social equality. He mentioned that NSS volunteers identified illiterate villagers and created awareness about the importance of literacy.

He added that literacy is essential for community development, as illiteracy often leads to poverty, unemployment, and social backwardness. By becoming literate, every individual can build their own life independently, without depending on others. Volunteers spread the message that education is a right for all, and providing at least basic education to everyone is a collective responsibility. Dr. G. Venkateswarlu, NSS Program Officer, Department of Arts, highlighted that as per the Right to Free and Compulsory Education guaranteed by the Constitution, all children between 6–14 years must receive free and compulsory education.

Dr. P. Sreekanth Reddy, NSS Program Coordinator, explained that for illiterate adults, the Government has introduced the New India Literacy Program (Education for All), where evening and weekend classes are conducted in nearby government schools, community centers, and through the DIKSHA online platform. With the help of volunteer instructors (teachers, NSS, and NCC students), learners are taught reading, writing, arithmetic, life skills, digital and financial literacy, and vocational training to become literate and self-reliant. Dr. K. Anil Kumar, Head of the Department of Arts, further reiterated the importance of these initiatives. Field Coordinator P. Suresh and the volunteers were congratulated and appreciated by the University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Pardha Saradhi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, Dr. K. Rajasekhar Rao, Advisors Dr. Habeebulah Khan, and other dignitaries.

Outcome:

Awareness on Education for out-of-school children on International Literacy Day program successfully created awareness among villagers about the importance of education and literacy. Several illiterate individuals were identified and motivated to enroll in literacy initiatives. NSS volunteers gained valuable exposure to community service and understood their role in promoting social change. The event emphasized that literacy is a key tool for overcoming poverty, unemployment, and inequality. Overall, the program inspired both students and villagers to work together toward building an educated and self-reliant society.
