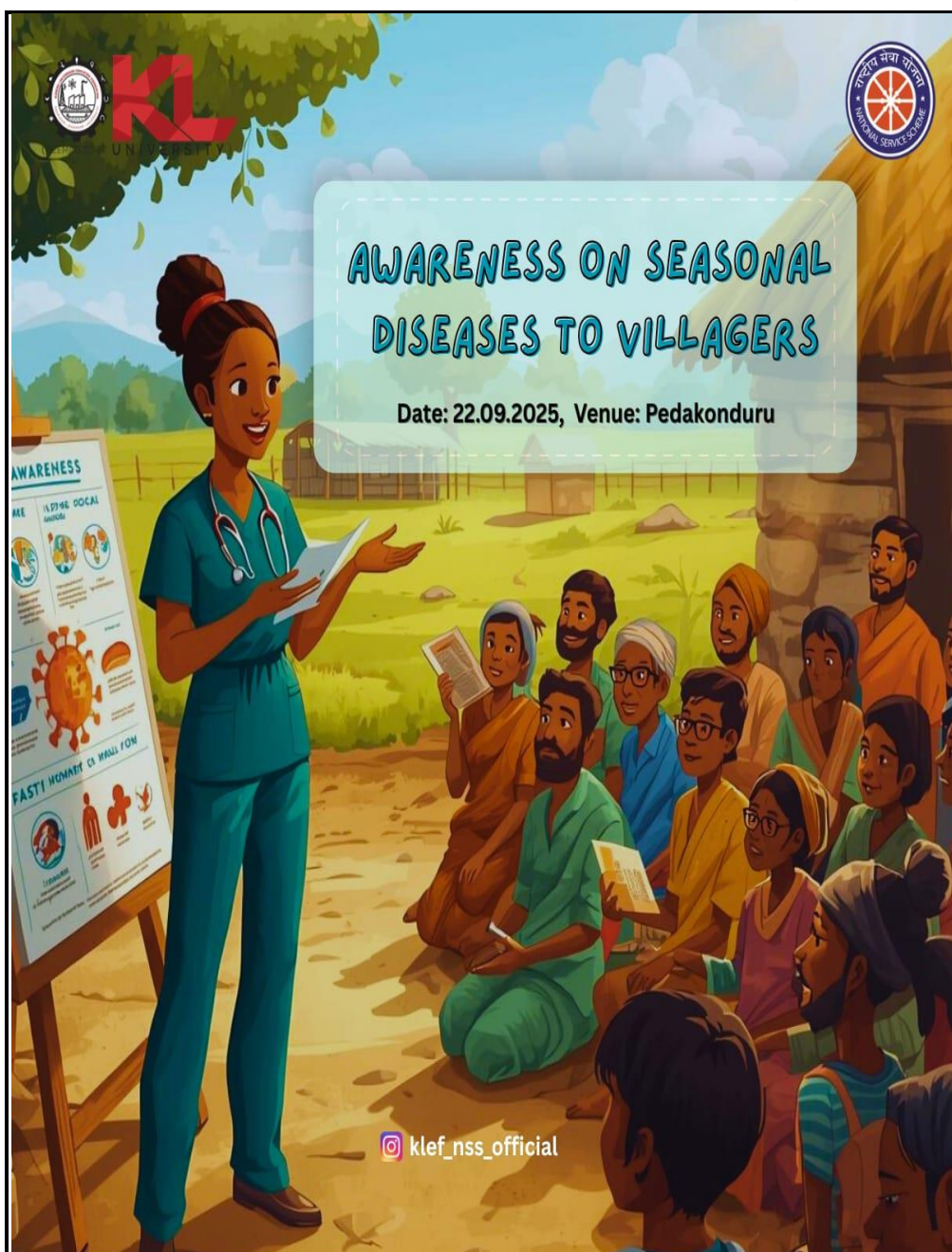

Objective:

The objective of the NSS program on awareness of seasonal diseases is to educate communities about the causes, symptoms, and preventive measures related to illnesses that commonly occur during specific seasons, such as dengue, malaria, chikungunya during the monsoon, heatstroke in summer, and flu in winter. The program aims to promote healthy practices like maintaining personal hygiene, using mosquito repellents, drinking safe water, and ensuring proper sanitation. By organizing activities such as rallies, health camps, poster campaigns, and door-to-door awareness drives, NSS volunteers play a vital role in spreading knowledge and encouraging community participation in disease prevention. This initiative not only helps in reducing the spread of seasonal diseases but also fosters a sense of social responsibility and leadership among the youth

Description:

As part of the Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan programme initiated by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, KL University National Service Scheme (NSS) organized a programme on Monday 22nd September 2025 at Pedakonduru village, Duggirala Mandal. During this event, the CSE-3 departments conducted an Awareness Programme on Seasonal Diseases, informed Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Dean of Student Welfare, KL Deemed University.

On this occasion, he said that every individual has the responsibility not only to maintain personal hygiene but also to keep their surroundings clean, which in turn helps prevent health issues. Volunteers went door-to-door educating people not to dump garbage in drains or on roads, but instead to dispose of it in waste collection vehicles. They also advised households to prevent stagnation of rainwater and wastewater to maintain cleanliness, explained Dr. A. Senthil Athithan, Head of the CSE-3 Department, stated that stagnant sewage in drains, discarded coconut shells, tires, and unused water containers create breeding grounds for mosquitoes, leading to the spread of fevers like Dengue, Malaria, and Chikungunya. People were advised to use mosquito nets, consume hygienic food, and consult doctors if fever persists for more than three days.

The efforts of the NSS volunteers were appreciated by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. PardhaSaradhi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, Dr. K. Rajasekhara Rao, Dean Dr. Habeebulla Khan, and Programme Coordinator Dr. P. Sreekanth Reddy, Programme officer Mr. R. Vijay along with NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh.

Outcome:

The awareness programme on Seasonal Diseases conducted at Pedakoduru village brought significant outcomes. Villagers realized the importance of maintaining both personal and community cleanliness to safeguard their health. They were educated on proper waste disposal methods and the need to prevent water stagnation to avoid mosquito breeding. The community also gained awareness about protecting themselves from diseases like Dengue, Malaria, and Chikungunya by following hygienic practices. Overall, the event fostered a sense of responsibility among the villagers towards building a healthier and cleaner environment.

Impact on Society:

The event made a positive impact on society. It helped in building a more informed and health-conscious community by educating people about the importance of hygiene, sanitation, and timely prevention during disease-prone seasons. The program reduced misinformation and encouraged early diagnosis and treatment, which can help lower the spread and severity of diseases like dengue, malaria, and flu. Community participation in cleanliness drives and awareness rallies fostered a sense of collective responsibility, leading to cleaner surroundings and improved public health conditions.
