Objective:

The objective of the “Awareness on Maintaining Clean Surroundings” program is to educate individuals about the importance of cleanliness in promoting a healthy and hygienic environment. It aims to encourage students and community members to actively participate in keeping their surroundings neat and waste-free. The program seeks to instill a sense of responsibility and discipline towards proper waste disposal and sanitation practices. It also emphasizes the role of cleanliness in preventing diseases and enhancing overall well-being. Ultimately, the initiative aspires to create a sustainable and clean community through collective efforts.

Description:

Under the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of KL University, as part of the Swachh Bharat Mission and Swachhata Hi Seva campaign, organized an awareness program on clean surroundings and diarrheal disease on Tuesday, 23rd September 2025, at Veerlapalem village, Duggirala Mandal, said Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. R. Vijay, NSS Program Officer, cautioned that consuming contaminated water and food can lead to diarrhea, which can be life-threatening if neglected. Under the guidance of the NSS CSE-4 Unit, volunteers went door-to-door educating villagers about the causes, preventive measures, and treatment for diarrhea. They explained that poor sanitation, unclean surroundings, consumption of contaminated food, and not washing hands properly are the main causes of this disease.

Villagers were advised to drink boiled and cooled water, eat fresh food, wash hands with soap, and avoid street or stored food. The volunteers also informed that symptoms such as frequent loose motions, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, fever, dehydration, and weakness require immediate medical attention. Dr. P. Sreekanth Reddy, NSS Program Coordinator, and volunteers led the awareness efforts, while NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh acted as the event coordinator.

The event was appreciated by KL University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Pardhasaradhi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkatram, and Dr. K. Rajasekhara Rao, Advisor Dr. Habeebullah Khan, CSE-4 Head Dr. A. Senthil Athithan, and Veerlapalem Village Sarpanch B. Srinivasa Reddy.

Outcome:

The outcome of the awareness program on clean surroundings and diarrheal disease was highly positive. Villagers gained valuable knowledge about the causes, symptoms, and prevention of diarrhea. They understood the importance of maintaining personal hygiene, using clean drinking water, and keeping their surroundings sanitary. The active participation of NSS volunteers encouraged community involvement in promoting health and cleanliness. Overall, the event led to improved public awareness and a commitment toward a disease-free and hygienic village environment.

Impact on Society:

The awareness program had a significant impact on society by promoting better hygiene and sanitation practices among rural communities. It encouraged people to adopt healthy habits such as washing hands, using safe drinking water, and avoiding contaminated food. This initiative helped reduce the risk of waterborne diseases like diarrhea and improved public health awareness. The collective effort of NSS volunteers fostered a sense of responsibility toward maintaining clean surroundings. Ultimately, the program contributed to building a healthier, safer, and more conscious society.




