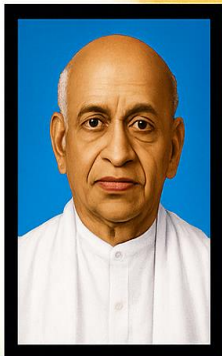

Distribution of Essential Commodities and Educational Materials
