Objective:

- To commemorate 150 years of Vande Mataram and honour its historical legacy.
- To participate in the nationwide program announced by the Central Government.
- To instill patriotism, unity, and cultural awareness among students.
- To involve youth in national celebrations of literary and cultural significance.

Description:

The year 2025 marks the 150th anniversary of India's national song "Vande Mataram," originally written by Bankimchandra Chatterji on November 7, 1875. To honour this historic milestone, the Government of India launched a year-Long National Commemoration on November 7, 2025, inaugurated by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. As part of this celebration, the nation will witness: Public mass singing events, Release of a commemorative postal stamp and coin, Cultural programs across India, Special events at Indian embassies worldwide

The Central Government urged citizens—students, employees, and the general public—to participate in collective singing of "Vande Mataram" on this auspicious day. Responding to the national call, The NSS Cell of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, KL University, organized a Mass Singing of "Vande Mataram" in all classrooms on November 7, 2025, with enthusiastic participation from students and faculty. At 10:00 AM, students across the campus stood in unity and chanted "Vande Mataram" in their respective classrooms. The chant resonated through the academic blocks, reflecting patriotism, cultural pride, and respect for India's heritage.

The NSS Cell of the Department of CSE coordinated and monitored the event to ensure smooth execution. Faculty members briefed students about: The historical importance of the national song, The role of Bankimchandra Chatterji in India's literary and nationalist movements, The significance of the 150-year milestone. This activity aligned with the government's vision to encourage daily chanting and widespread cultural engagement. The Vande Mataram – 150 Years Mass singing program at KL University was graced by respected dignitaries who addressed the students and appreciated the initiative. Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Dean – Student Affairs, emphasized the cultural and historical significance of Vande Mataram, reminding students that the song has been a symbol of unity and patriotic spirit since the freedom movement. He appreciated the active participation of students in preserving national heritage. Dr. B. Tirupathi Reddy, Head of the Department of CSE, highlighted the role of youth in upholding national values and

encouraged students to engage in such culturally enriching activities. He commended the NSS volunteers for their disciplined involvement.
