Objective:

The objective of creating awareness on diabetes among villagers is to educate them about the causes, symptoms, and risk factors of diabetes. It aims to promote early detection through regular health check-ups and blood sugar testing. The program encourages healthy lifestyle practices such as balanced diet, regular physical activity, and stress management. It also highlights the importance of timely medication and adherence to medical advice. Awareness helps prevent complications related to diabetes through proper care and monitoring. Overall, the objective is to improve the quality of life and reduce the burden of diabetes in rural communities.

Description:

Under the joint auspices of KL University National Service Scheme (NSS) and Youth Red Cross (YRC), volunteers from the College of Pharmacy conducted an awareness program on diabetes, informed the Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K. R. S. Prasad. The program was organized for the villagers of Srungarapuram village in Duggirala Mandal, where the Pharmacy volunteers were divided into teams and went door to door to create awareness. They educated the villagers on how diabetes occurs, the precautions that can be taken to prevent it, and the types of treatment and care required after the onset of the disease, stated the Principal of the College of Pharmacy, Dr. G. Chakravarthi. Dr. R. Supriya, Professor In-charge of the Youth Red Cross, highlighted that in the present times, diabetes is affecting people of all age groups without distinction. She emphasized that diabetes can be prevented and controlled by adopting a healthy lifestyle, ensuring adequate sleep, consuming a nutritious and balanced diet, and engaging in regular physical activity or exercise. She also stressed the importance of regular health check-ups and early diagnosis to avoid complications.

NSS Programme Coordinator Mr. P. Srikanth Reddy cautioned that excessive consumption of junk food, cool drinks, and processed foods leads to obesity, which in turn increases the risk of diabetes. He advised people to avoid such foods and instead include fruits, nuts, dry fruits, and traditional millets such as ragi, jowar, bajra, foxtail millet, little millet, and barnyard millet in their daily diet to maintain good health. The program was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers who actively participated in the awareness campaign were appreciated and congratulated by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of the University, Dr. G. Parthasaradhi Varma; Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkatram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao; Registrar Dr. K. Subba Rao; Principal Dr. V. Rajesh; and Advisors to the Dean of Student Affairs, including Dr. Habibulla Khan, among others.

Outcomes:

The diabetes awareness program resulted in increased knowledge among villagers about the causes, symptoms, and prevention of diabetes. Many residents understood the importance of early detection, regular health check-ups, and timely treatment. The program motivated people to adopt healthier lifestyles, including balanced diets and regular physical activity. Villagers became aware of the harmful effects of junk food and processed foods on health. The door-to-door interaction helped clear doubts and encouraged active participation from the community. Overall, the event strengthened health awareness and promoted preventive healthcare practices in the village.

The diabetes awareness program created a positive impact on society by improving public understanding of diabetes and its long-term effects. It encouraged community members to make informed health choices and adopt preventive lifestyles. The initiative helped reduce myths and misconceptions related to diabetes through direct interaction with villagers.
