**Objective:**

The objective of creating Awareness on Health issues caused by Pollution is to educate people about the serious health risks associated with polluted Air, Water, Soil, and Noise. It aims to help individuals understand how pollution leads to diseases such as asthma, heart problems, skin disorders, and infections. Another objective is to encourage people to adopt preventive measures and eco-friendly habits in daily life. It also seeks to motivate communities to actively participate in pollution control and environmental protection. Special emphasis is given to safeguarding vulnerable groups like children, the elderly, and pregnant women. Ultimately, the goal is to promote a healthier society and a cleaner, sustainable environment.

**Description:**

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), Regional Directorate of NSS, and State NSS, the NSS Unit of the Department of CSE-2, KL University, organized a public awareness programme on pollution on Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2025, at Pedapalem village in Duggirala Mandal, said Dr.K.R.S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. He stated that the programme aimed to educate people about the causes and harmful effects of pollution and to encourage everyone to take personal responsibility in preventing it. NSS Programme Coordinator Mr.P. Srikanth Reddy emphasized that only through collective effort can a pollution-free society be achieved.

The speakers explained that pollution mainly occurs in the form of air, water, soil, and noise pollution. Air pollution is caused by vehicle emissions, harmful gases released from factories and industries, burning of garbage and plastics, dust from construction activities, and forest fires. Water pollution occurs when industrial chemicals and sewage are discharged into rivers, canals, and ponds, when pesticides used in agriculture mix with water, and when plastic waste is dumped into water bodies. Soil pollution results from the excessive use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides, dumping of plastic and solid waste on land, and the mixing of industrial waste with soil. Noise pollution is caused by vehicle horns, loudspeakers, and machinery in factories, construction activities, and bursting of crackers. NSS Programme Officer Dr.Ch.Nagamani stated that these forms of pollution have a severe impact on human health and the environment, making preventive measures essential. He added that NSS volunteers went door to door to create awareness among the villagers.

The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr.P.Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated and encouraged by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, Dr.B.Tirupati Reddy and others.

**Outcome:**

The pollution awareness programme created a positive impact by improving public understanding of the causes and harmful effects of air, water, soil, and noise pollution. Villagers became more conscious of their daily practices that contribute to environmental degradation. The door-to-door interaction by NSS volunteers helped in effective communication and better community participation. People were motivated to adopt eco-friendly habits such as reducing plastic use and proper waste disposal. The programme encouraged collective responsibility towards pollution prevention. Overall, the event strengthened environmental awareness and promoted sustainable living practices among the public.

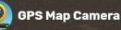
