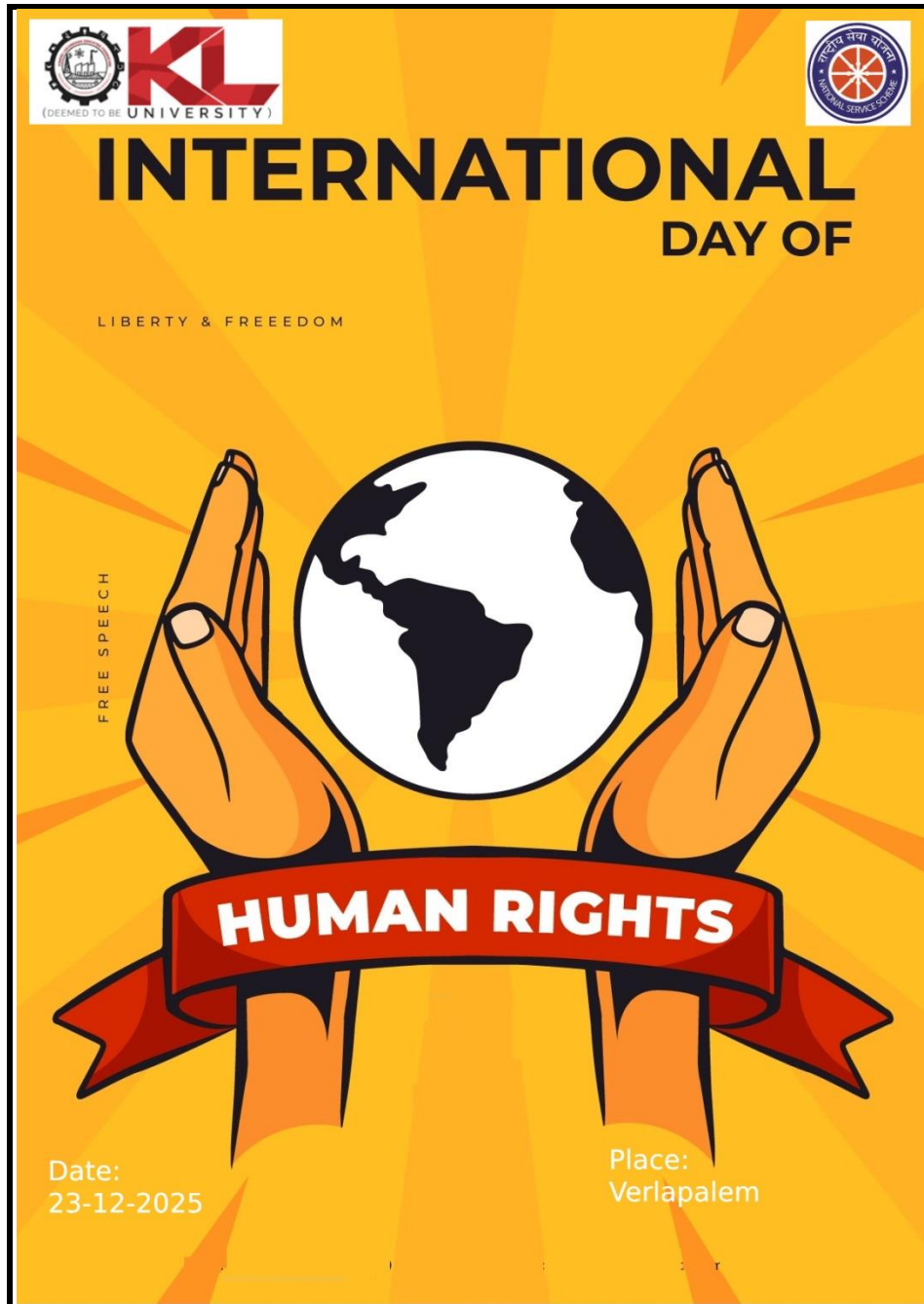

### Awareness on Human Rights to Villagers



Event : Awareness on Human Rights to Villagers

**Objective:**

The objective of awareness on human rights is to educate people about their fundamental rights and freedoms guaranteed to every individual. It aims to promote equality, dignity, and respect irrespective of caste, gender, religion, or background. Human rights awareness helps individuals recognize and oppose injustice, discrimination, and exploitation. It empowers people to seek legal remedies and protection against violations. The programme encourages active citizenship and responsible participation in a democratic society. Ultimately, it contributes to building a just, inclusive, and peaceful society.

**Description:**

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Unit of the Department of CSE-4, KL University organized a public awareness programme on Human Rights on Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2025, at Verlapalem village in Duggirala Mandal, said Dr. K. R. S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. Addressing the gathering, he explained that human rights are the natural rights every individual possesses to live with dignity, freedom, and without fear. He stated that these rights are inherent from birth and were formally recognized and proclaimed worldwide by the United Nations through the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in 1948. In India, human rights are protected under the Fundamental Rights enshrined in the Constitution (Articles 12–35), said Dr. Pawan Kumar, Head of the Department.

NSS Programme Coordinator Mr.P. Srikanth Reddy explained that human rights can broadly be classified into five major categories. These include civil and political rights, such as the right to life, personal liberty, freedom of speech, right to vote, and equality before law. Economic rights relate to economic security, including the right to employment, equal wages, and protection from poverty. Social rights ensure a dignified life in society, such as the right to education, health, and housing. Cultural rights protect the freedom to preserve one's language, culture, traditions, and religion. Environmental and collective rights include the right to clean air and water, the right to live in a peaceful environment, and the right to development. NSS Programme Officer Mr.G.Mohanarao emphasized that the protection of human rights is a shared responsibility of the government, society, and individuals. He stated that individuals must be aware of their own rights, respect the rights of others, and stand against discrimination and injustice. At the government level, human rights are safeguarded through the Constitution, laws, courts, and the establishment of human rights commissions. He also informed that NSS volunteers conducted door-to-door campaigns to spread awareness among the villagers.

The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr.P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.
