Objective:

The objective of the campaign on energy conservation is to create awareness about the importance of saving energy for sustainable development. It aims to educate people on efficient use of electricity and other energy resources in daily life. The campaign encourages the adoption of energy-efficient practices and renewable energy sources. It seeks to reduce energy wastage and lower environmental pollution. Promoting responsible energy consumption helps in conserving natural resources for future generations. Overall, the campaign supports economic savings, environmental protection, and energy security.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Unit of the Department of ECE, KL University organized a public awareness programme on Energy Conservation on Friday, 31st December 2025, at Revendrapadu village in Tadepalli Mandal, said Dr. K. R. S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. Speaking on the occasion, he explained that energy conservation means using natural resources judiciously by reducing the wastage of electricity, fuel, and other resources and utilizing only what is necessary. He emphasized that significant energy savings can be achieved through small changes in daily habits.

Dr. A. Senthil, CSE-3, Head of the Department, stated that people should switch off lights, fans, and electrical appliances when not in use, use LED bulbs, avoid frequently opening refrigerator doors, and maintain air conditioners at 24–26°C. He also suggested using power-saving devices in offices and educational institutions, switching off computers and printers after use, making use of natural sunlight, and reducing unnecessary travel. He further encouraged the use of public transport, carpooling, cycling, and walking, along with adopting renewable energy sources such as solar energy, wind energy, and biogas. NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikanth Reddy emphasized that energy conservation is not an individual effort but a collective responsibility, and everyone must contribute towards saving energy.

NSS Programme Officer Mr. G.Mohanarao highlighted that energy conservation leads to economic benefits such as reduced electricity bills and fuel costs, while also lowering pollution and global warming. He added that conserving energy helps protect natural resources, ensures energy availability for future generations, reduces energy crises, improves air quality, and enhances public health. The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr.P. Suresh. The NSS volunteers were appreciated by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.
