Event : Awareness on the Causes of Cancer
Date : 31-12-2025

Objective:

The objective of the Awareness on the Causes of Cancer is to educate people about the major risk factors and lifestyle habits that lead to cancer. It aims to promote healthy behaviors and reduce exposure to preventable causes such as tobacco use, poor diet, and lack of physical activity. The program seeks to encourage early identification of warning signs and symptoms. It also focuses on correcting myths and misconceptions related to cancer. Another objective is to motivate people to undergo regular health checkups and screenings. Overall, the awareness program strives to reduce cancer incidence through knowledge, prevention, and responsible health practices.

Description:

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Units of the College of Pharmacy, KL University organized a public awareness programme on Cancer on Wednesday, 31st December 2025, at Atmakur village under the Tadepalli–Mangalagiri Municipal Corporation limits. This was stated by Dr. G. Chakravarthi, Principal, College of Pharmacy, KL University. He explained that cancer is a condition in which the body's cells grow abnormally and uncontrollably. He stated that cancer can be caused by factors such as tobacco consumption, alcohol intake, unhealthy diet, hereditary reasons, and excessive exposure to sunlight, viral infections, harmful chemicals, and radiation. The programme focused on educating the public about how cancer develops, how it can be identified at an early stage, and where and for how long treatment should be taken.

NSS Programme Officer Dr. R. Supriya said that symptoms such as unexplained weight loss, prolonged fever, lumps anywhere in the body, long-lasting pain, and persistent fatigue may indicate cancer. She explained specific warning signs including mouth ulcers and bleeding in oral cancer, persistent cough or coughing up blood in lung cancer, lumps and pain in breast cancer, abnormal bleeding in cervical cancer, and frequent infections and weakness in blood cancer. She advised people not to delay medical consultation if such symptoms appear. She further explained that cancer can be diagnosed through medical investigations such as blood tests, X-rays, CT scans, MRI, biopsy (cell sample testing), Pap smear, and mammography for women. Early diagnosis and timely treatment can significantly improve recovery chances, she added.

The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P.Suresh. The NSS volunteers were appreciated by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G.Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S.Prasad, Dr. N.Venkataram, and Dr. K.Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K.Subbarao, Principal Dr. V.Rajesh, Student

Affairs Deans Dr. K.R.S.Prasad and Dr. Habibullah Khan, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, NSS Programme Coordinator Mr.P.Srikanth Reddy, and other dignitaries.

Outcome:

The cancer awareness programme helped villagers understand what cancer is and how it develops in the human body. People became aware of major risk factors such as tobacco use, alcohol consumption, unhealthy diet, and hereditary causes. The programme enabled the public to identify early warning signs and symptoms of different types of cancer. Awareness about timely medical consultation and early diagnosis was strengthened. Participants learned about available diagnostic tests and treatment options. Overall, the event promoted preventive behavior and encouraged early detection for better health outcomes.

Impact on Society:

The cancer awareness programme created a significant social impact by improving public understanding of cancer prevention and early detection. It helped reduce fear and myths associated with cancer through scientific information. Increased awareness encouraged people to adopt healthier lifestyles and avoid risk factors such as tobacco and alcohol. The programme promoted timely health check-ups and early medical intervention. It strengthened community responsibility towards supporting cancer patients and their families. In the long run, such initiatives contribute to improved public health and reduced cancer-related mortality in society.
