**Objective:**

The objective of the Seasonal Diseases Awareness Campaign conducted on the occasion of the Special Camp is to educate the community about common seasonal diseases and their causes. The campaign aims to create awareness on early symptoms and the importance of timely medical consultation. It focuses on promoting preventive measures such as personal hygiene, safe drinking water, and proper sanitation. The programme also encourages healthy lifestyle practices to reduce the risk of seasonal infections. Another objective is to dispel myths related to seasonal illnesses through correct health information. Overall, the campaign seeks to improve public health awareness and prevent the spread of seasonal diseases in the community.

**Description:**

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), the Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Unit-12 of the College of Pharmacy, KL University organized an awareness programme on Seasonal Diseases on Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026, at Kolanukonda village under the Tadepalli-Mangalagiri Municipal Corporation limits, said Dr. G. Chakravarthi, Principal, College of Pharmacy, KL University. He advised the public to remain alert about seasonal diseases that commonly occur during winter. He specifically cautioned about scrub typhus, a life-threatening fever caused by the bite of mite-like insects, and emphasized that anyone experiencing fever should immediately consult a medical professional.

NSS Programme Officer Dr. R. Supriya explained that respiratory problems such as asthma and pneumonia are common during the winter season. She stated that pneumonia is a lung infection caused by viruses, bacteria, or fungi, leading to fluid-filled air sacs in the lungs, whereas asthma is a chronic condition characterized by inflammation and narrowing of the airways. NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikanth Reddy informed that NSS volunteers were divided into groups and conducted door-to-door awareness campaigns to educate villagers about seasonal diseases, their symptoms, and preventive measures.

The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh. The efforts of the volunteers were appreciated by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Student Affairs Deans Dr. K. R. S.
