**Objective:**

The objective of the Voter Enrollment Awareness Initiative is to educate citizens about the importance of registering as voters in a democratic system. It aims to motivate eligible voters, especially youth and first-time voters, to enroll and actively participate in elections. The initiative spreads awareness about the voter registration process, required documents, and deadlines. It also seeks to eliminate misconceptions and barriers related to voter enrollment. Through community outreach and awareness programs, the initiative promotes informed and responsible voting. Ultimately, it strives to strengthen democracy by ensuring maximum and inclusive voter participation.

**Description:**

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), the Regional Directorate, and State NSS, KL University NSS in association with the CSE-2 Department organized awareness programmes on New Voter Registration on Wednesday, 7th January 2026, at Nuthakki village in Mangalagiri Mandal, said Dr. K. R. S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. He stated that the right to vote is one of the most valuable rights in a democratic system and emphasized that every eligible citizen must register as a voter. With this objective, the programme focused on creating awareness about new voter registration, especially among first-time voters.

NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikanth Reddy explained that the programme aimed to sensitize youth who have completed 18 years of age about the importance of voter registration. He highlighted that voting is not only a right but also a responsibility, and that voter registration enables every citizen's voice to be reflected in democracy, paving the way for good governance. The programme provided clear information on the procedure for new voter registration, required documents, and both online and offline application processes. Participants were also informed about voter registration initiatives undertaken by the Election Commission of India, including registration through Form-6, and the process for address changes and corrections.

NSS Programme Officer Dr. C. H. Nagamani urged the youth to develop political awareness and to participate responsibly by voting in every election. Head of the Department Dr. Tirupati Reddy stated that the programme significantly increased interest in voter registration, particularly among young citizens, and strengthened the sense of participation in safeguarding democracy. He added that such initiatives create social awareness and lay a strong foundation for a vibrant and robust democracy. NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh informed that volunteers were divided

into groups and conducted door-to-door campaigns to spread awareness. He also coordinated the programme. The efforts of the volunteers were appreciated by Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A. V. S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Dean Dr. Habibullah Khan, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.

### **Outcome:**

The new voter registration awareness programme helped people understand the importance of enrolling as voters in a democratic system. Youth who attained 18 years of age became aware of their right and responsibility to vote. The programme clarified the procedure, documents required, and online and offline methods for voter registration.
