**Objective:**

The objective of the Free Mega Medical Camp for villagers on the occasion of the Special Camp is to provide accessible healthcare services to rural communities. It aims to offer free medical check-ups and early diagnosis of common health problems. The camp seeks to create awareness about preventive healthcare and healthy lifestyle practices. It helps villagers receive timely medical advice and guidance from healthcare professionals. The programme focuses on reducing health inequalities in rural areas. Overall, it strives to improve community health and well-being.

**Description:**

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), the Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Unit-12 of the College of Pharmacy, KL University successfully organized a “Free Mega Medical Camp” as part of a Special Camp on Friday, 9th January 2026, at Kolanukonda village under the Tadepalli–Mangalagiri Municipal Corporation limits, said Dr. G. Chakravarthi, Principal, College of Pharmacy, KL University. He stated that the camp provided villagers with free medical check-ups, medical consultations, and essential medicines without any cost. The camp included services such as general health check-ups, blood pressure and blood sugar tests, ECG, eye examinations, bone and joint care, women’s health services, and pediatric health check-ups.

NSS Programme Officer Dr. R. Supriya informed that expert medical services were provided by specialists, including ophthalmologists from Amaravathi Eye Hospital, general physician Dr. Chandrasekhar, dental specialist Dr. Shashidhar from Duhitha Dental Hospital, ENT technician Kiran Kumar, and Marketing Manager MD. Shamsuddin, along with other qualified healthcare professionals. Dean of Student Affairs Dr. K. R. S. Prasad stated that due to limited access to healthcare facilities in rural areas, the free mega medical camp proved highly beneficial to villagers. A large number of residents utilized the camp to assess their health conditions. Immediate medical advice was provided, and patients requiring further treatment were identified and guided appropriately for future care.

The organizers noted that the programme significantly increased health awareness among villagers and emphasized the importance of preventive medical check-ups. NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikanth Reddy stated that such free medical camps play a vital role in improving community health and well-being. NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh informed that volunteers were divided into groups and conducted door-to-door awareness campaigns to encourage villagers to utilize the medical camp. He also coordinated the programme. The NSS volunteers were

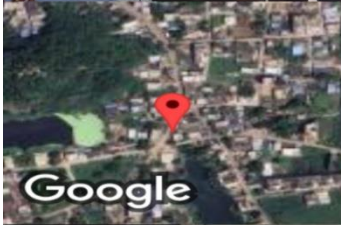

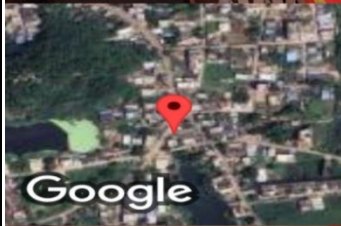

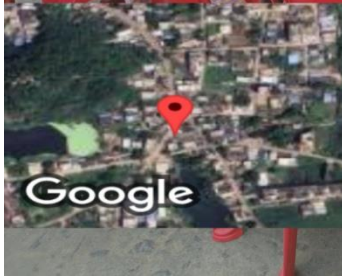
