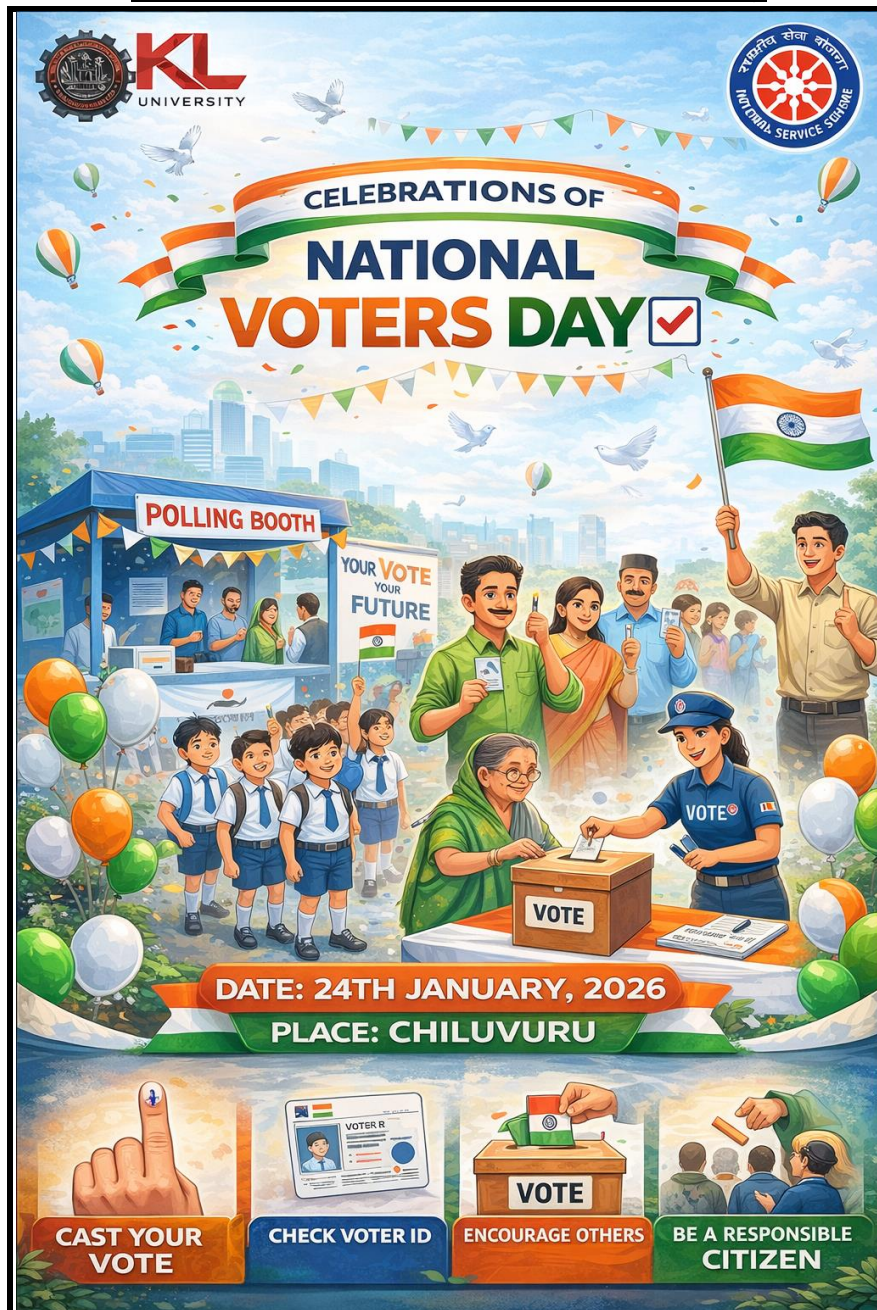

Objective:

National Voters Day is celebrated to encourage citizens, especially young people, to participate in the democratic process by exercising their right to vote. It aims to increase voter awareness about the importance of voting in a democracy. The day also promotes voter registration among eligible citizens. It highlights the responsibility of every voter in choosing good leadership. National Voters Day helps strengthen democratic values and active citizenship. Overall, the celebration motivates people to participate responsibly in elections.

Description:

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), the Regional Directorate, and State NSS, KL University NSS in association with the Department of Arts organized National Voters Day on Saturday, 24 January 2026, at Chiluvuru village in Duggirala Mandal, said Dr. K. R. S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. He stated that an awareness programme on new voter registration was being conducted and emphasized that the right to vote is one of the most valuable rights in a democratic system. He further said that every eligible citizen must register as a voter. With this objective, the programme focused on creating awareness about new voter registration, especially among first-time voters.

NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikanth Reddy explained that the programme aimed to create awareness among youth who have completed 18 years of age about the importance of voter registration. He highlighted that voting is not only a right but also a responsibility. He stated that voter registration enables every citizen's voice to be reflected in democracy and paves the way for good governance. The programme provided clear information about the procedure for new voter registration, required documents, and the process of applying through both online and offline modes. Participants were also informed about voter registration initiatives undertaken by the Election Commission of India, including registration through Form-6, as well as the process for address changes and corrections.

NSS Programme Officer Dr. Venkateswarlu urged the youth to develop political awareness and participate responsibly by casting their votes in every election. Head of the Department Dr. Tirupati Reddy stated that the programme greatly helped in increasing interest in voter registration, especially among youth, and strengthened their participation in protecting democracy. He added that such initiatives help in creating social awareness and lay a strong foundation for a vibrant and strong democracy. NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh

informed that volunteers were divided into groups and conducted door-to-door awareness campaigns in the village. He also coordinated the programme.
