Objective:

The objective of awareness on clean roads is to educate people about the importance of maintaining cleanliness in public spaces. It aims to encourage individuals to avoid littering and adopt responsible waste disposal practices. The programme promotes a sense of civic responsibility and community participation in keeping roads clean. It also helps in preventing health hazards caused by unhygienic surroundings. Through awareness activities, people are motivated to contribute to a cleaner and greener environment. Ultimately, the initiative strives to build a culture of cleanliness for a healthier society.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), KL University NSS in association with the Department of MCA organized an “Awareness on Cleanliness of Roads” programme in Vaddeswaram village of Tadepalli Mandal on Tuesday, 11th February 2026, informed Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. He stated that maintaining clean roads helps in reducing diseases and ensures a healthy environment. He also emphasized that improper waste disposal leads to the breeding of mosquitoes and flies, which cause various illnesses.

Dr. C.H. Kiran Kumar, Head of the MCA Department, highlighted the importance of not throwing waste on roads and encouraged people to use dustbins, promoting the habit of “Use Dustbin.” He further explained that separating wet waste (food waste) and dry waste (plastic and paper) helps in protecting the environment. NSS Programme Coordinator P. Srikant Reddy suggested creating awareness about the harmful effects of plastic usage and encouraged the use of cloth bags. He also mentioned that dumping waste in drains leads to water stagnation, which results in mosquito breeding, and advised people to avoid such practices.

The Programme Officer explained that individuals should take responsibility for maintaining cleanliness in front of their homes and surroundings. The awareness programme also focused on healthy living, clean surroundings, environmental protection, disease prevention, and the objectives of initiatives like “Swachh Bharat,” encouraging public participation. The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh. The efforts of the volunteers were appreciated by KL University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, Dr. K. Rajasekhara Rao, Dean Advisors Dr. Habibulla Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subba Rao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Dean Dr. Habibulla Khan, Associate Dean Dr. Shantha Sri, and other dignitaries.

Outcome:

The awareness programme on clean roads resulted in increased understanding among villagers about the importance of maintaining cleanliness in their surroundings. People became more conscious about avoiding littering and started using dustbins for proper waste disposal. The initiative encouraged the segregation of wet and dry waste, promoting environmentally friendly practices. Participants also gained awareness about the health risks caused by unhygienic conditions, such as the spread of diseases through mosquitoes and flies. The programme motivated individuals to take personal responsibility for keeping their streets and surroundings clean. Overall, it fostered a positive attitude towards community participation and sustainable cleanliness practices.
