**Objective:**

The main objective of creating awareness on GPS trackers for vehicle safety is to educate individuals about the importance of installing GPS tracking systems in vehicles to enhance safety, prevent theft, enable real-time monitoring, ensure quick emergency response, and promote responsible vehicle usage. The campaign aims to inform people about the benefits, legal aspects, and practical applications of GPS technology in ensuring personal and public safety.

**Description:**

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, along with the Regional Directorate and State NSS, the NSS Unit of KL University in association with the Department of AI&DS organized an awareness program on GPS Trackers for Vehicle Safety on Monday, 16-02-2026, in Atmakur village of Mangalagiri Mandal. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that the program was conducted by NSS volunteers as part of their community outreach activities.

AI&DS Head of the Department, Dr. V.S.V. Prabhakar, mentioned that the volunteers, organized in groups, conducted door-to-door visits to explain the working of GPS (Global Positioning System). They educated vehicle owners on how GPS helps in real-time tracking of vehicle movement, prevention of theft, ensuring the safety of drivers and passengers, and providing assistance during emergencies such as accidents or breakdowns.

NSS Program Coordinator, Dr. P. Srikant Reddy, explained that the volunteers also created awareness among villagers about the benefits of GPS tracking in school buses, public transport, and private vehicles. They provided information on features such as emergency alerts, route tracking, geo-fencing, and mobile app monitoring, highlighting how technology enhances road safety and accountability.

NSS Program Officer, V. Jonithin, stated that villagers actively participated in the session and showed keen interest by asking questions about installation procedures, costs, and practical usage. NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh coordinated the event and ensured its smooth execution.
