**Objective:**

The objective of awareness on Safe Driving and E-Learning for students is to promote responsible road behavior and reduce accidents. It aims to educate individuals about traffic rules, the importance of helmets and seat belts, and the risks of negligent driving. The programme also highlights the dangers of using mobile phones while driving. In addition, it encourages students to adopt e-learning platforms for continuous education and skill enhancement. It helps in improving digital awareness and access to quality learning resources. Ultimately, the initiative strives to build disciplined drivers and technologically empowered students.

**Description:**

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, National Service Scheme (NSS), KL University NSS in association with the Department of CSE-2 organized an “Awareness on Safe Driving & E-Learning for Students” programme in Pedapalem village of Duggirala Mandal on Tuesday, 17th February 2026, informed Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, KL University. He stated that through the safe driving awareness programme, students and vehicle users were educated about the importance of road safety. Awareness was created on following traffic rules, using helmets and seat belts, and controlling speed. Dr. B. Tirupati Reddy, Head of the CSE-2 Department, highlighted the dangers of using mobile phones while driving and the risks associated with drunk driving.

NSS Programme Coordinator Dr. P. Srikant Reddy explained precautions to be taken during night driving, risks of skidding during rainy conditions, and how to stay alert in rural areas where animals may suddenly cross the roads. NSS Programme Officer Dr. C.H. Nagamani emphasized understanding traffic signals, the use of zebra crossings, and giving priority to pedestrians through practical examples. She also stressed the importance of responsible driving behavior to reduce negligence among youth and enhance road safety awareness among all users.

Later, an e-learning programme was conducted for students of the ZP High School, where practical awareness on the use of modern educational tools was provided. Students were guided on how to learn effectively using online platforms, virtual classrooms, and video lectures. Skills such as time management, preparation for online exams, and note-making were also introduced. Interactive activities and small tasks were conducted to enhance digital skills, along with guidance on managing screen time and protecting eye health. She stated that the programme played a key role in developing self-learning abilities among students.

The programme was coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator P. Suresh. Faculty member Jonathan also participated in the programme. The efforts of the volunteers were appreciated by KL University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi

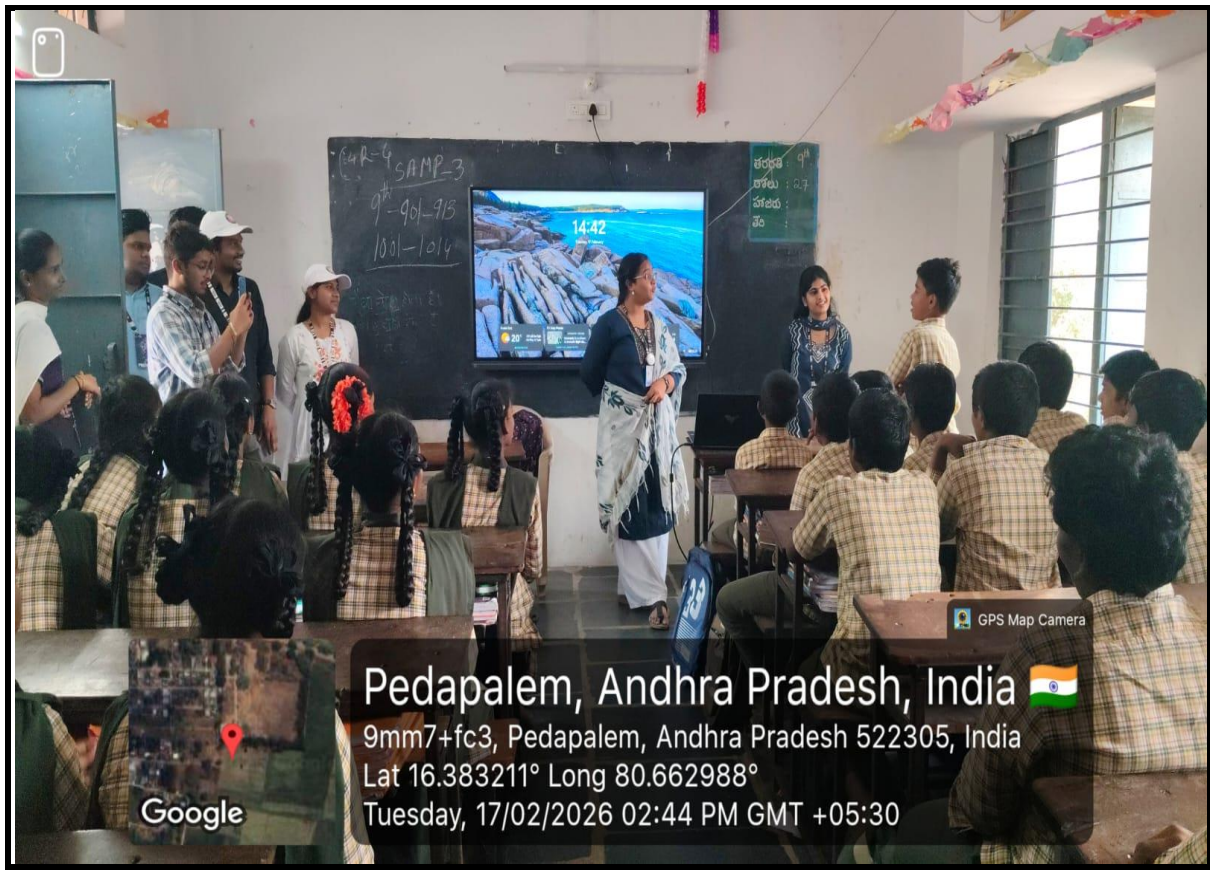
