Objective:

The objective of the Health Survey and PHC Cleaning Drive is to assess the health conditions and basic needs of the community. It aims to identify common health issues and create awareness about hygiene and preventive care. The program also focuses on maintaining cleanliness in Primary Health Centres to ensure a safe and healthy environment for patients. Overall, it promotes community well-being through improved health awareness and sanitation practices.

Description:

As per the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Regional Directorate, and State NSS, the NSS Unit of KL University in association with the CSE-2 Department organized a special camp on Friday, 20-02-2026, in Pedapalem village of Duggirala Mandal. As part of the camp, NSS volunteers conducted a door-to-door awareness campaign about an upcoming free medical camp and also carried out a health survey. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. 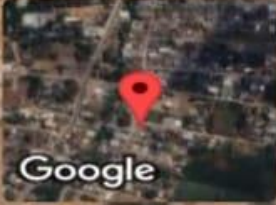
