Event : Awareness on Fire Safety for Electronic Devices

Date : 23-02-2026

Objective:

The objective of the awareness program on Fire Safety for Electronic Devices is to educate people about preventing fire accidents caused by improper use of electrical and electronic equipment. It aims to create awareness about safe handling, proper wiring, and avoiding overloading of electrical circuits. The program also emphasizes the importance of regular maintenance and using quality devices. Overall, it promotes safety practices to prevent hazards and protect lives and property.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-7 of the ECE Department, KL University organized an awareness program on “Fire Safety for Electronic Devices” on Monday, 23rd February 2026, in Prathuru village of Tadepalli Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that the program was conducted by NSS volunteers for the benefit of the community. He mentioned that the volunteers, organized into teams, conducted door-to-door campaigns to educate villagers about the risks of fire accidents caused by improper usage of electronic devices such as mobile phones, chargers, televisions, and laptops. They explained that following proper safety measures can help protect lives and property.

Head of the ECE Department, Dr. I. Govardhani, highlighted that using old or damaged wires, low-quality or duplicate chargers, overloading a single plug point with multiple devices, and leaving devices switched on for long durations can lead to fire hazards. She stressed the importance of avoiding such practices. NSS Program Coordinator, Dr. P. Srikant Reddy, advised villagers to switch off devices after use, use only original and quality chargers, regularly check wires and plugs, and avoid overloading electrical sockets. He also emphasized ensuring that children do not handle electronic devices carelessly.

NSS Program Officer, Dr. K. Venkata Kishore, explained that in case of sparking or smoke from devices, the power supply should be turned off immediately. He advised not to use water to extinguish electrical fires, but instead to use a fire extinguisher or sand, and to inform fire services if necessary. He emphasized that awareness and small precautions can prevent major accidents and ensure safety at home and in society.

The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their service by University Vice-

Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, along with Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.

Outcome:

The outcome of the program was effective as villagers gained awareness about fire safety measures related to electronic devices. They understood the risks caused by improper usage such as overloading, faulty wiring, and use of low-quality chargers. The session encouraged them to adopt safe practices and take precautions to prevent fire accidents. Overall, the program enhanced safety awareness and helped in protecting lives and property.

Impact on Society:

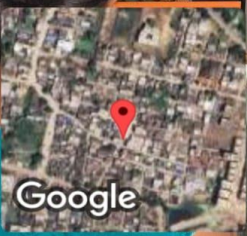
