Objective:

The objective of the awareness program on Good Touch, Bad Touch, and Hygiene is to educate children about personal safety and body awareness. It aims to help them understand the difference between safe and unsafe touch and encourage them to speak up in uncomfortable situations. The program also promotes the importance of personal hygiene for maintaining good health. Overall, it empowers children to stay safe, confident, and healthy in their daily lives.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-3 of the CSE-3 Department, KL University organized an awareness program on “Good Touch, Bad Touch and Personal Hygiene” on Tuesday, 24th February 2026, at the Zilla Parishad High School in Revendrapadu village of Duggirala Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. NSS Field Coordinator, Mr. P. Suresh, ensured the smooth conduct of the program and actively coordinated the event.
