**Objective:**

The objective of the awareness program on scams offering high investment returns is to educate people about fraudulent schemes that promise unrealistic profits. It aims to help individuals identify warning signs such as guaranteed returns, pressure tactics, and unverified sources. The program also encourages people to verify investment opportunities before investing their money. Overall, it promotes financial awareness and helps protect individuals from economic fraud.

**Description:**

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-7 of the ECE Department, KL University organized an awareness program on “Scams Offering High Investment Returns” on Tuesday, 24th February 2026, in Prathuru village of Tadepalli Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that the program was conducted to educate the public about financial frauds. He mentioned that many people are being deceived by investment schemes that promise high returns in a short period. NSS volunteers, organized into teams, conducted door-to-door campaigns to create awareness about such scams and explained how fraudsters attract people by exploiting their desire to earn quick money.

Head of the ECE Department, Dr. I. Govardhani, explained that common signs of such scams include promises of unusually high returns, claims of zero risk, pressure to invest immediately, and lack of proper registration or official information. She also warned that fraudsters often use statements like “Invest now or lose the opportunity” to mislead people. NSS Program Coordinator, Dr. P. Srikant Reddy, advised villagers to verify the authenticity and registration of any investment organization before investing. He emphasized not to trust unknown sources or suspicious links, and to never share sensitive information such as bank details or OTPs. He also highlighted that offers guaranteeing high profits are often fraudulent. NSS Program Officer, Dr. K. Venkata Kishore, stated that individuals should stay alert and spread awareness among family and community members. He added that small precautions can prevent major financial losses and that NSS volunteers play a key role in protecting society from such scams through awareness initiatives.

The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their efforts by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N.

Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, along with Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.

**Outcome:**

The outcome of the program was effective as villagers gained awareness about investment scams and their warning signs. They learned to identify fraudulent schemes promising high returns and understood the importance of verifying information before investing. The session encouraged them to be cautious and avoid sharing sensitive financial details. Overall, the program helped in preventing financial losses and improving financial awareness in the community.

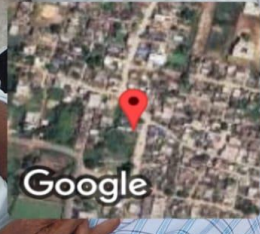
