**Description:**

He stated that building the belief that "everyone is equal" is key to creating a better society. The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their efforts by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N. Venkataram, and Dr. K.
