Objective:

The objective of the awareness program on the dangers of minors driving is to educate youth and parents about the legal restrictions and risks of underage driving. It aims to highlight the potential dangers such as accidents, injuries, and loss of life due to lack of experience. The program also emphasizes the importance of following traffic rules and obtaining a valid driving license. Overall, it promotes responsible behavior and road safety in society.

Description:

As per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, National Service Scheme (NSS), and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, the NSS Unit-7 of the ECE Department, KL University organized an awareness program on the “Dangers of Minor Driving” on Friday, 27th February 2026, in Prathuru village of Tadepalli Mandal as part of the NSS Special Camp. Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad, stated that the program was conducted to educate vehicle users and the public.

Head of the ECE Department, Dr. I. Govardhani, explained that minors (individuals below 18 years of age) driving vehicles is not only illegal but also poses a serious threat to their lives and the safety of others. She highlighted that minors often lack proper driving experience, have limited knowledge of traffic rules, and are unable to accurately judge road conditions, which increases the risk of accidents. She also noted that reckless behavior and over speeding can lead to severe road accidents.

NSS Program Coordinator, Dr. P. Srikanth Reddy, emphasized that driving without a valid license can result in penalties, and in some cases, legal action may also be taken against parents or vehicle owners. He added that such incidents can lead to financial and social consequences for families. Accidents involving minors can result in serious injuries, disabilities, or even loss of life, affecting their future at an early age.

NSS Program Officer, Dr. K. Venkata Kishore, advised parents to monitor their children and prevent them from driving vehicles. He also suggested that schools and colleges should conduct awareness programs on this issue and emphasized the importance of following traffic rules and obtaining a valid driving license before operating any vehicle.

The program was successfully coordinated by NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh. The volunteers were appreciated for their efforts by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. A.V.S. Prasad, Dr. N.

Venkataram, and Dr. K. Rajashekhara Rao, along with Dean Advisors Dr. Habibullah Khan, Registrar Dr. K. Subbarao, Principal Dr. V. Rajesh, Associate Dean Dr. Shanta Sri, and other dignitaries.

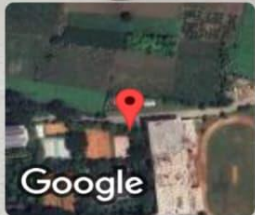
