Objective:

The objective of the Free Dental Checkup Camp is to provide accessible dental screening and basic oral health services to the community. It aims to create awareness about proper oral hygiene, preventive dental care, and the importance of regular dental checkups. The camp focuses on early identification of dental problems and encourages people to seek timely professional treatment. Overall, it promotes better oral health and contributes to a healthier community.

Description:

As per the directions of the National Service Scheme (NSS) under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, and in accordance with the guidelines of the Regional Directorate, Hyderabad, and Andhra Pradesh State NSS, KL University NSS, in association with the CS&IT Department, organized a Social Responsibility and Community Service Programme on Wednesday, 29 July 2026 at the premises of the Zilla Parishad High School in Pedavadlapudi village, Mangalagiri Mandal, Guntur District. A Free Dental Checkup Camp was conducted for school students and local villagers, informed University Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. K.R.S. Prasad.

CS&IT NSS Programme Officer Dr. N. Praveen advised the participants to brush their teeth at least twice a day using fluoride toothpaste and rinse their mouth with clean water after meals to maintain healthy teeth and gums. He also emphasized the importance of limiting the consumption of chocolates, sweets, soft drinks, and junk food to prevent dental problems. NSS Programme Coordinator Dr. P. Srikant Reddy advised people not to ignore symptoms such as toothache, swollen gums, or bleeding gums and to consult a dentist promptly. He recommended using an individual toothbrush, replacing it every three months, and undergoing dental checkups once every six months for both children and adults to identify dental problems at an early stage.

NSS Field Coordinator Mr. P. Suresh coordinated the programme and ensured its successful implementation. The university authorities appreciated the NSS volunteers and the dental professionals from Sibara Institute of Dental Sciences—BNS. Jahnvi, CH. Deepika, D. Srivaishnavi, and B. Jeevanajyothi—for their valuable medical services.

The participants and medical team were appreciated by University Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Parthasarathi Varma, Pro Vice-Chancellors Dr. N. Venkataram and Dr. K.
