Code of Ethics

The University has a policy on all sorts of Research Misconduct such as fabrication, falsification, plagiarism, or other serious deviation from accepted practices in proposing, carrying out, or reporting results from research;

Plagiarism takes many forms, from "passing off" another's paper as the author's own, to copying or paraphrasing substantial parts of another's paper (without acknowledgement), to claiming results from research conducted by others. Plagiarism in all its forms constitutes unethical publishing practice and deserves condemnation.

The R&D division ensures that all submitted thesis/research papers being considered for award of degrees undergo through plagiarism detection software "Turnitin" and an Anti-Plagiarism certificate to be issued by the office of Dean (R&D) for submission of thesis.
