

KL EEE – 25 Examination pattern in line with JEE for PCM Students:

For Admission into (UG Engineering Programs)

The test is 3 hours duration. The test paper consists of 75 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (PCM) has 25 questions. The maximum marks are 75. This question paper contains Three Parts. Part-A is Physics, Part-B is Chemistry and Part-C is Mathematics.

KL SAT – 25 Examination pattern in line with NEET for PCB Students:

For Admission into (UG Life Sciences, Pharmacy, Agriculture, Food Tech... etc.,)

The test is 1.5 hours duration. The test paper consists of 90 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (BZ) has 25 questions and (PC) has 20 questions. The maximum marks are 90. This question paper contains Three Parts. Part-A is Physics, Part-B is Chemistry, Part-C is Botany and Part-D Zoology.

KL EEE – 25 for other states - MBIPC

For Admission into (UG Engineering Programs, Life Sciences)

The test is 3 hours duration. The test paper consists of 150 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (MPCB) has 45 questions. The maximum marks are 150. This question paper contains Four Parts. Part-A is Maths, Part-B is Physics, Part-C is Chemistry and Part-D Biology.

KL MAT – 25

For Admission into (PG Management Programs)

The test is 60 minutes duration. The test paper consists of 60 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (QA, LR, GE) has 60 questions. The maximum marks are 60. This question paper contains Three Parts. Part-A is Quantitative Aptitude, Part-B is Logical Reasoning and Part-C is General English.

KL HAT – 25

For Admission into (UG Management, Computational and Allied Programs)

The test is 90 minutes duration. The test paper consists of 90 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (MACS, ELC) has 25 questions and (GA & LAB) has 20 questions. The maximum marks are 90. This question paper contains four Parts. Part-A is Management Aptitude and communication Skills, Part-B is English Language and Comprehension, Part-C is General Awareness and Part-D Logical and Analytical ability.

KL ECET– 25 Examination pattern in line with ECET for Diploma Students:

For Admission into (UG Engineering Programs, Lateral Entry)

The test is 120 minutes duration. The test paper consists of 100 Multiple choice questions. Each subject (PCM) has 20 questions & Core 40. The maximum marks are 100. This question paper contains four Parts. Part-A is Physics, Part-B is Chemistry, Part-C is Mathematics and Part-D is Core.
