His first invention was “wide fax machines” which are used to fax civil construction plan sheets,electrical data sheets to other countries where the plans were compiled and sent back to india through fax machines, this made a revolution in infrastructure industry. Due to this invention he was 1<sup>st</sup> recorded in Guinness book of records. Next by inventing world

Thinnest scanner he was 2<sup>nd</sup> time recorded in Guinness book of records.

**Summary:**

### ***FICCI Workshop on IP(Intellectual Property)\_***

**Seminar Title: Made in India and Made for India**

**Summary:**

The Session on Intellectual Property covered aspects on IP basics, including key criteria to choose between different types of IP protection, viz., Patent, Trademark, Copyright or Geographical Indication. Some common myths surrounding patent protection and recent emerging trends in patents scenario in India are discussed. It is said that like a land is registered an idea should also be registered. For Technology inventions Patents are registered, validity lasts for 20 years. For artistic works copyrights should be taken, validity is for life time. To get differentiation from others Trade Marks should be taken, validity is for 10 years. There are only local patents but no global patents. Aspects on patent monetization are covered ending with key case studies (of L.G & Samsung with Onida), both global and national.

This session also apprised the audience on the India Innovation Growth Programme, the nation-wide flagship Program that FICCI is executing with the Department of Science and Technology, Lockheed Martin Corporation, Indo-US Science and Technology Forum and the IC2 Institute at the University of Texas. This program created to enhance the growth and development of India's entrepreneurial economy aims to accelerate the launch of Indian early-stage technologies into the global marketplace.
