OBJECTIVES

The National Level Workshop on Pharmacovigilance, Hemovigilance, Meteriovigilance, and Adverse Events Following Immunisation aimed to provide insights into the importance of pharmacovigilance in patient safety, adverse events following immunisation (AEFI), hemovigilance, meteriovigilance, and methods of causality assessment in pharmacovigilance. The workshop also focused on the role of pharmacovigilance in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic and provided training on e-Filling of Suspected ADR forms and the PVPI Mobile App.

OUTCOMES


