Conclusion:

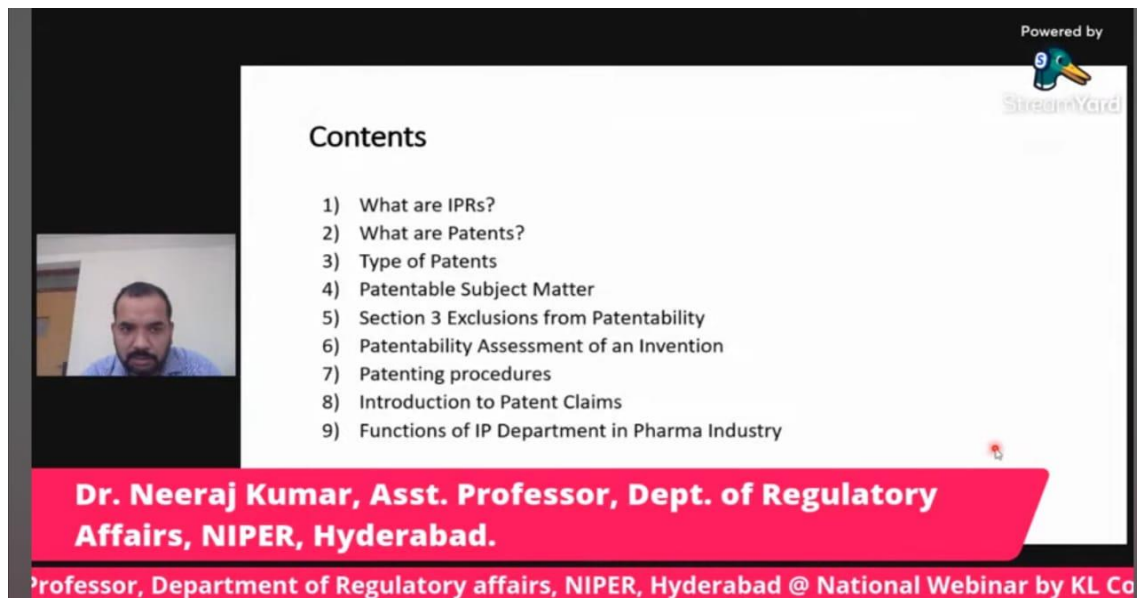


