On March 18, 2025, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM, **Dr. C. Karthikeyan**, Ph.D., Associate Staff Scientist from College of Pharmacy, University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, USA., delivered a talk on "**Regulating the Regulators: Targeting Protein Phosphorylation for New Drug Discovery**". Dr. Karthikeyan emphasized the critical role of protein kinases and phosphatases in cellular signaling and disease progression. He discussed how dysregulated phosphorylation is linked to various diseases, including cancer and neurodegenerative disorders. Novel strategies for selectively targeting these enzymes were discussed as promising avenues for therapeutic intervention. The session concluded with examples of current kinase inhibitors in clinical use and future perspectives in drug discovery.

- Kinases are enzymes that catalyze phosphorylation
- $ATP + \text{protein} \rightarrow ADP + \text{phosphoprotein}$
- Protein function altered by addition of a negatively charged phosphate group to a Ser, Thr, or Tyr residue:
 - Binding properties
 - Enzymatic activity if a catalytic protein
- Key role in cell signaling

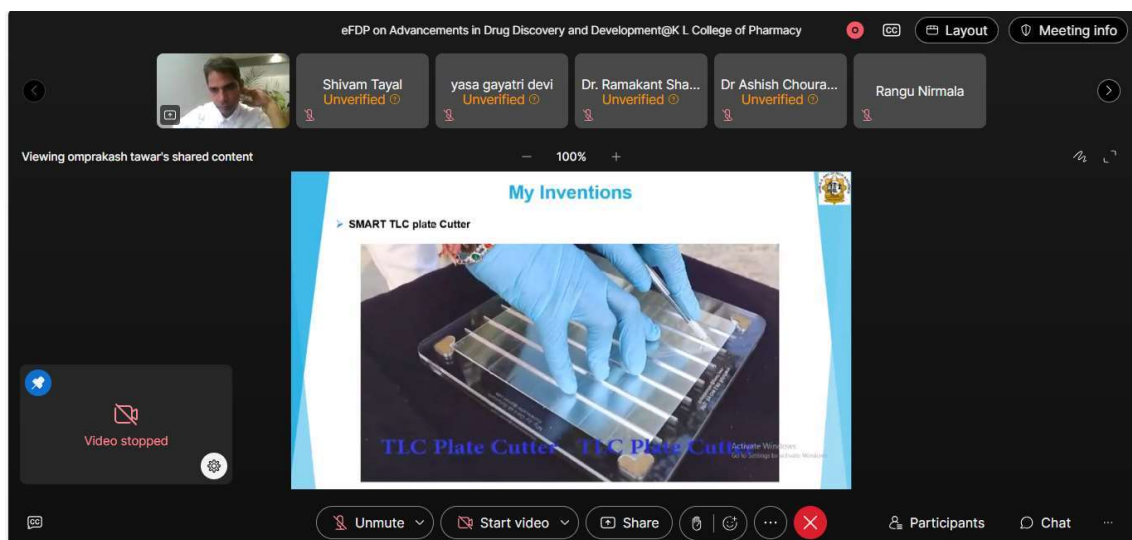
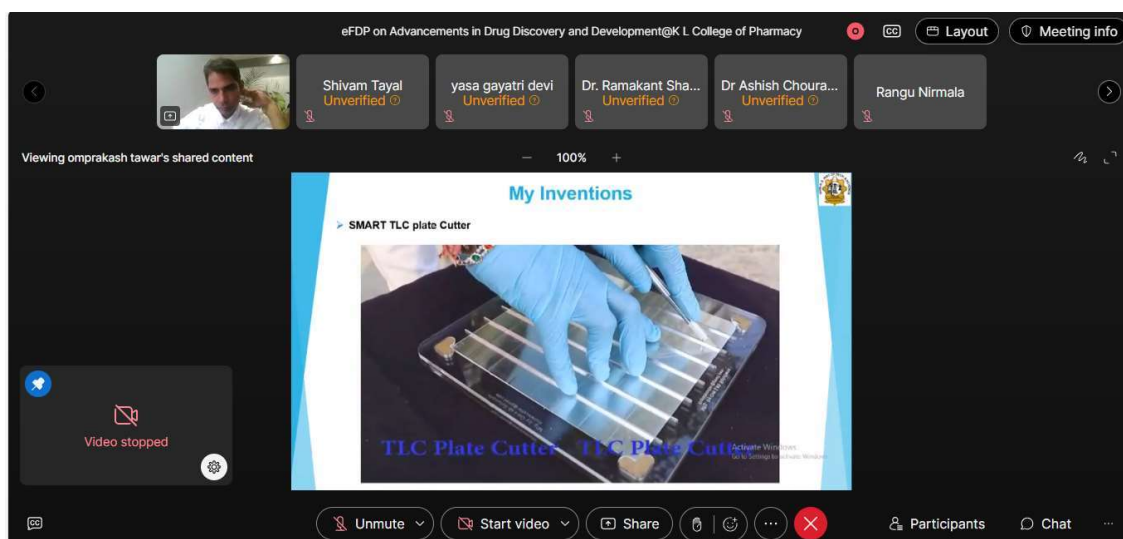

- Approaches of automatic docking
 - Treat the ligand and the macromolecular target as rigid bodies. This is acceptable if the active conformation of the ligand is known or if the ligand is a rigid cyclic structure.
 - the target is still considered as a rigid body, but the ligand is allowed to be flexible and can adopt different conformations.
 - Both the target and the ligand are considered to be flexible, which is extremely expensive in terms of computer time
 - Most docking studies are carried out by assuming a rigid target.
