Report on Day-1 session:

CSIR Sponsored NPE-2025 – Preconference workshop

Speaker: Mr. Krishna Chaitanya Kavungala, *Manager, Laila Nutraceuticals, Vijayawada* (Former Senior Scientist – Dr. Reddy's Laboratories, Aurigene Discovery Technologies, Dabur Research Foundation)

Session: Animal Models of Neuropharmacology: Pros and Cons

Timing: 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Mr. Krishna Chaitanya delivered an informative and practice-oriented session on the selection and applicability of animal models in neuropharmacology. He outlined the advantages and limitations of commonly used experimental models and stressed the importance of model validity, translational relevance, and feasibility when designing neuropharmacological studies.

He provided a clear overview of major disease-inducing models relevant to neuroinflammation associated **neurodegenerative diseases**. He also discussed key **neurobehavioral assessments** widely used in industry, drawing from his hands-on experience at Dr. Reddy's Laboratories and Dabur Research Foundation to highlight real-world considerations in preclinical screening and data interpretation.

A notable highlight of his visit was his **active involvement in hands-on training sessions**, where he guided delegates through the practical components of various neuropharmacological animal models. His demonstrations and interactive discussions greatly enhanced participants' understanding of experimental execution, troubleshooting, and behavioral scoring techniques.

The session concluded with an engaging Q&A segment that addressed practical challenges in animal research and clarified critical aspects of model interpretation. Overall, the session

was highly beneficial for participants working in neuropharmacology, offering both conceptual depth and valuable practical exposure.





Afternoon session

In the afternoon session, a practical workshop was conducted in the animal house. Participants were introduced to basic animal handling techniques, routes of administration, and demonstrations of key behavioural studies including the Morris Water Maze, Elevated Plus Maze, Y-Maze, Barnes Maze, Open Field Test, Novel Object Recognition Test, Actophotometer, Sucrose Preference Test, and other standard behavioural assays

The opening session of Day 2 was delivered by Dr. Saibalaji Andagulapati, who presented a highly insightful and forward-looking talk on the emerging connection between hepatic sinusoidal obstruction syndrome (HSOS) and neuropharmacology. A major highlight of the

session was the way Dr. Saibalaji illustrated the intricate crosstalk between hepatic pathology and neuroinflammation, offering a novel and impactful perspective for identifying therapeutic targets that bridge liver injury and neurological disorders. His scientific clarity and translational approach greatly enriched the understanding of the participants.



During his visit to KLEF University, Dr. Saibalaji actively interacted with the delegates as well as our pharmacy students, engaging in meaningful discussions on current research challenges and opportunities. Session 2: chemically engineered nanoparticles for targeted and immunotherapeutic interventions

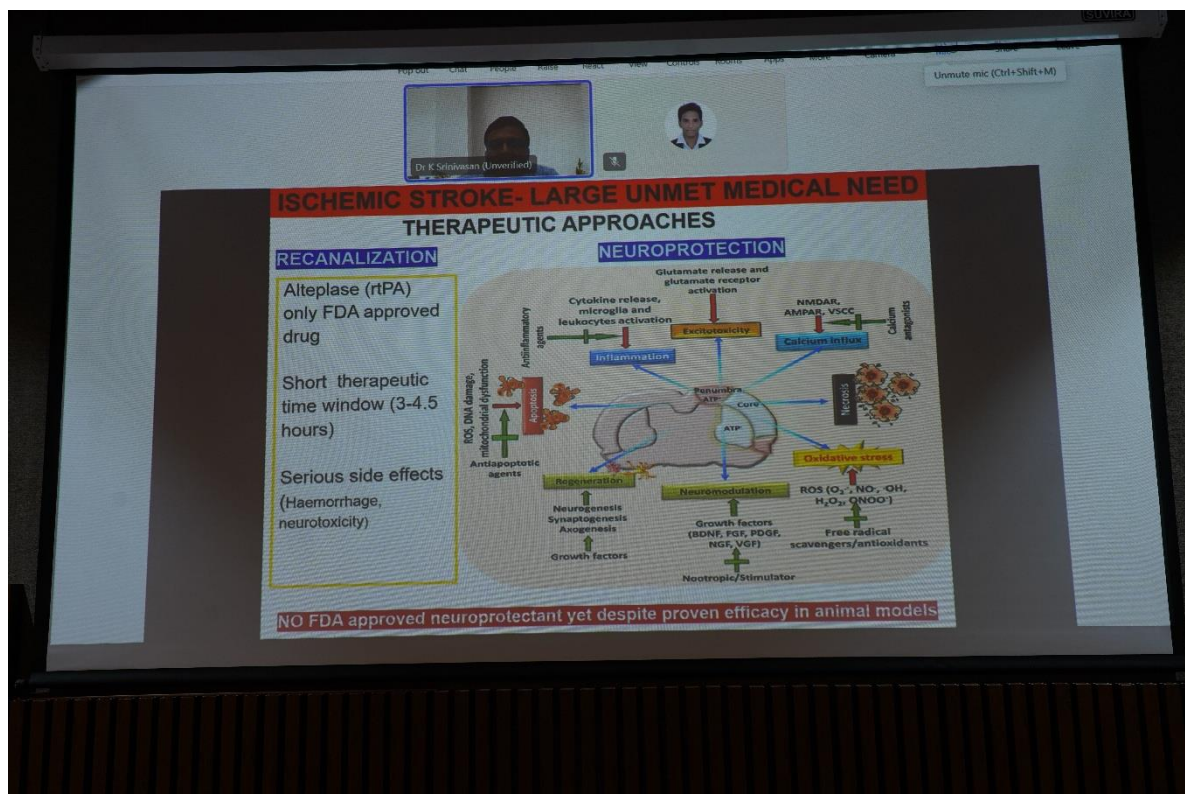

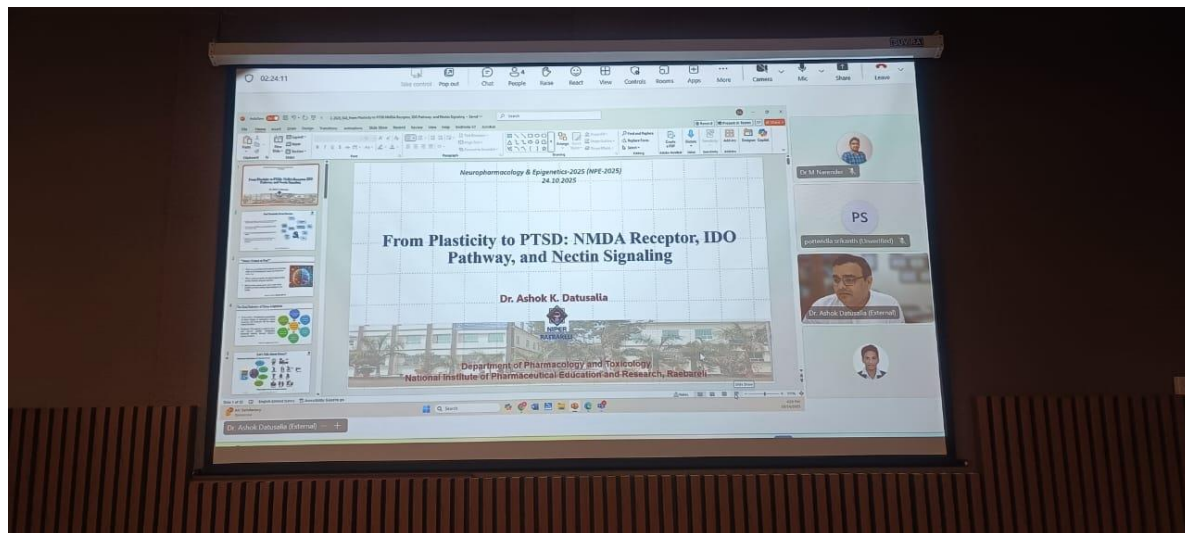

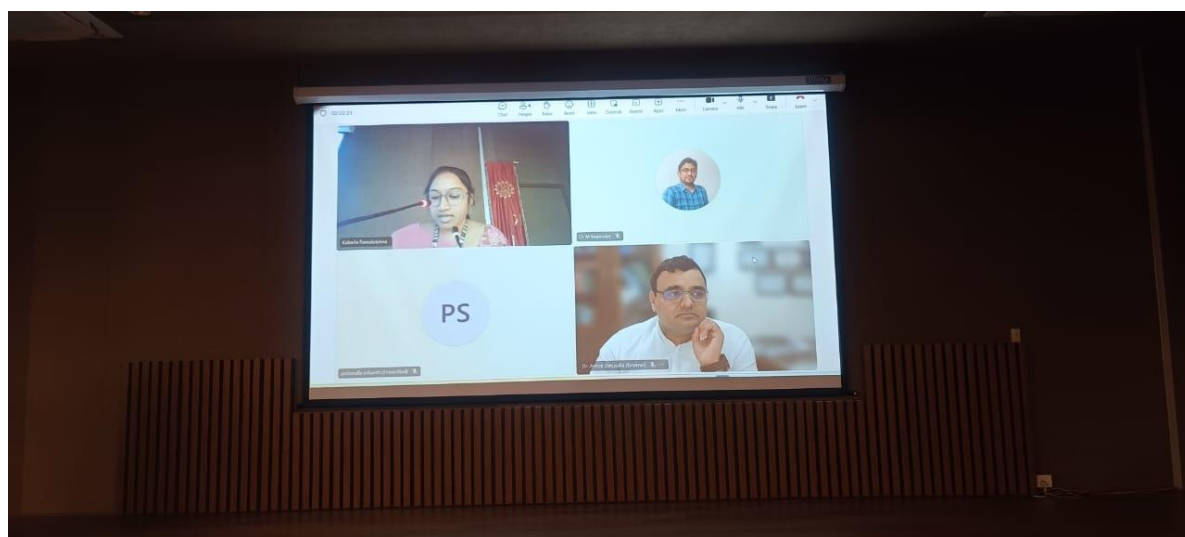

Session 4: From Plasticity to PTSD: NMDA Receptor, IDO Pathway, and Nectin Signaling
Resource Person: Dr. Ashok Dasuthalia, NIPER–Raebareli

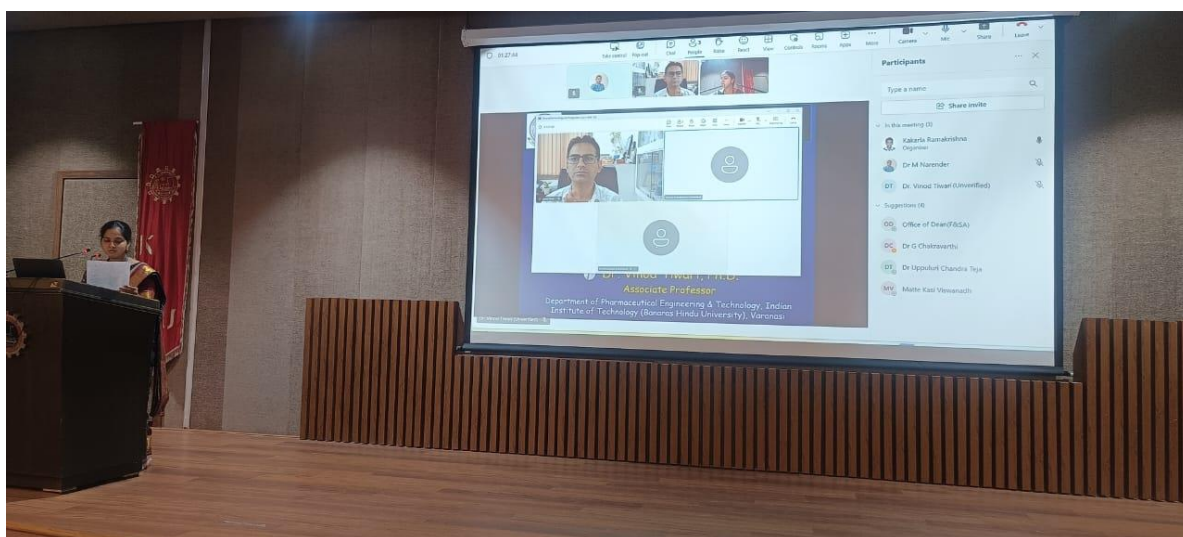
Session 5: Bridging the Gap: Neural Circuitry and Translational Approaches in Pain Research

Resource Person: Dr. Vinod Tiwari, IIT (BHU), Varanasi



The session by Dr. Vinod Tiwari provided an in-depth exploration of the dynamic interface between **neural circuitry** and **epigenetic mechanisms** in the context of neuropathic pain. He highlighted the central role of epigenetic modifications including DNA methylation, histone regulation, and non-coding RNA signaling in driving these long-term neural adaptations.

A key emphasis of the talk was the cross-talk between altered neural pathways and epigenetic remodeling, illustrating how these interconnected processes contribute to the persistence and severity of neuropathic pain. Dr. Tiwari also outlined emerging **translational research approaches**, focusing on molecular targets and circuit-level interventions that hold promise for developing improved therapeutic strategies.

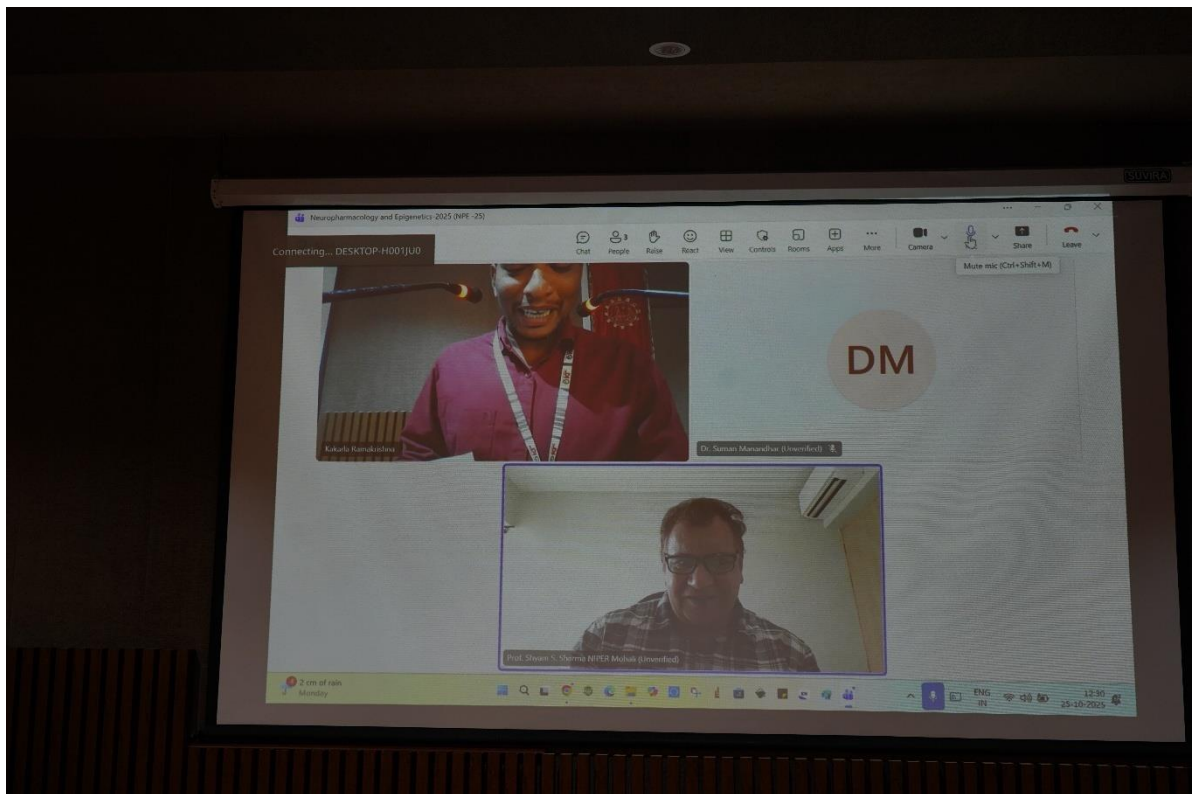
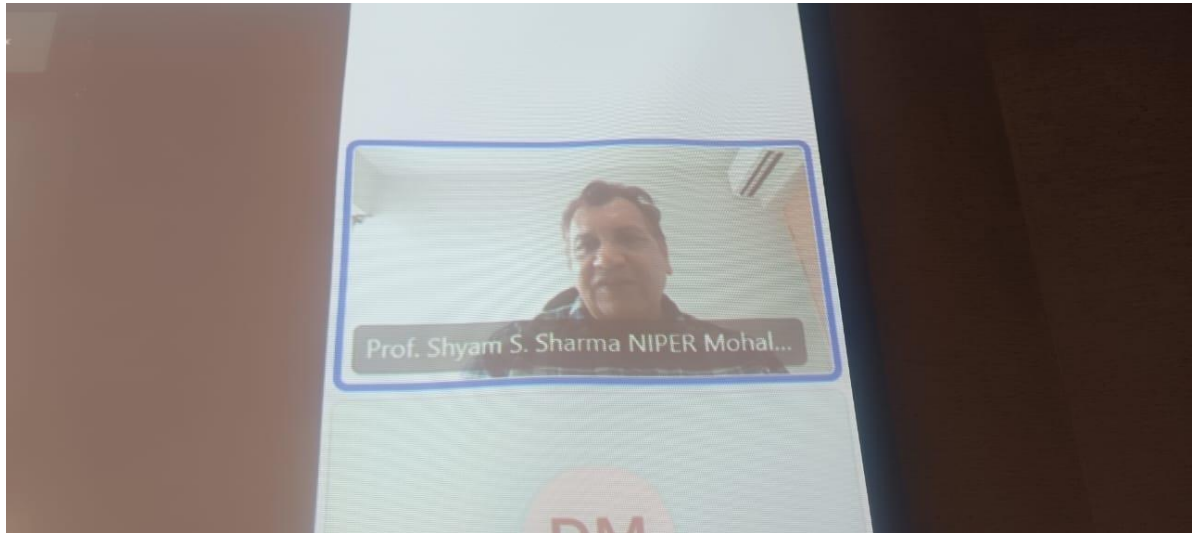


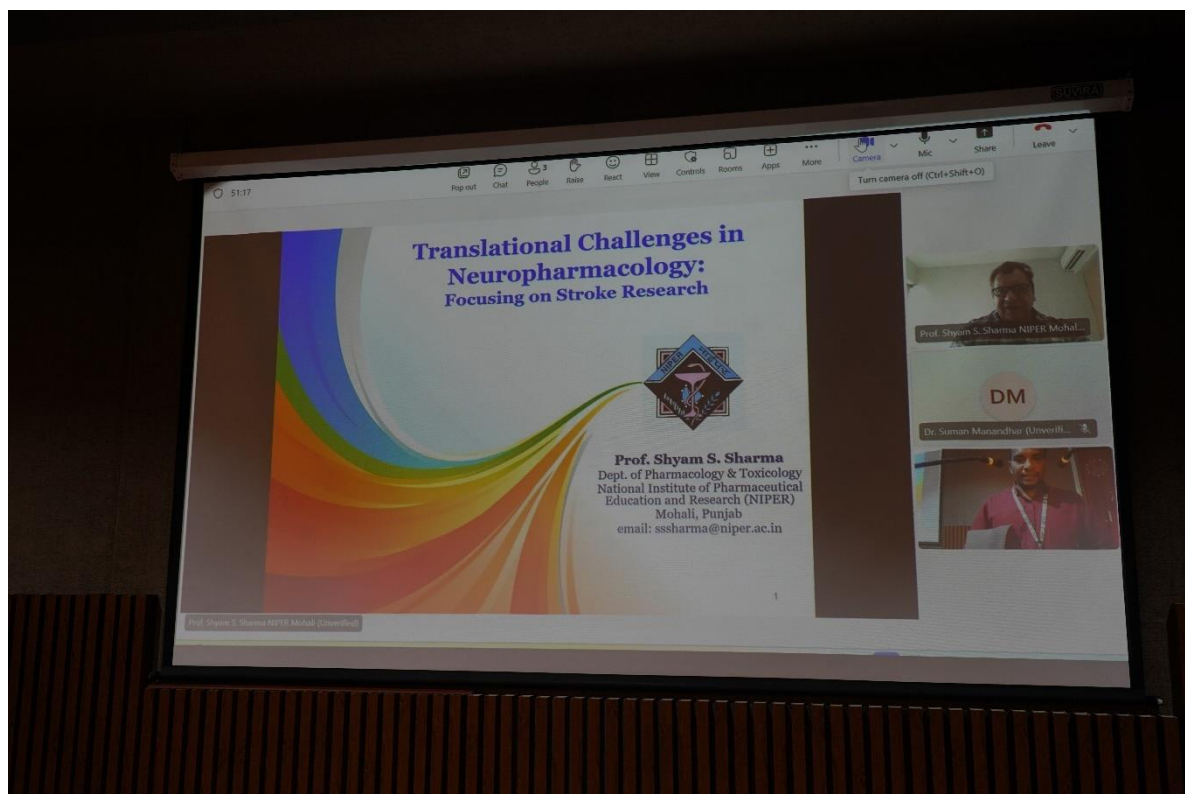


During his visit to **KLEF University**, Dr. Srikumar spent meaningful time with delegates, students, and faculty, sharing valuable neuroscience perspectives and personal research experiences that left a lasting impact on everyone. His warm interactions, guidance, and motivational discussions created truly memorable and heart-touching moments, making the session one of the most cherished highlights of the conference.



Dr. Suman Manandhar delivered a compelling lecture on the drug-discovery process, focusing on the identification of novel therapeutic molecules for Alzheimer's disease via modulation of the Wnt signaling pathway. He emphasized the application of computational studies to streamline early-phase drug discovery, showcasing how *in silico* methods can accelerate the identification of promising compounds. His talk highlighted the potential of Wnt pathway modulators as candidate drugs for Alzheimer's, underscoring the intersection of computational pharmacology and neurodegenerative disease research.





Title: *Translational Challenges in Neuropharmacology*

Resource Person: Dr. S. S. Sarma, NIPER–Mohali

The session delivered by Dr. S. S. Sarma provided a comprehensive and thought-provoking overview of the **translational challenges** that arise in bridging basic neuropharmacological research with clinical application. Focusing primarily on stroke mechanisms, epigenetic regulation, and their therapeutic implications, Dr. Sarma explained emerging evidence on how **epigenetic modifications** involved in the stroke and neurodegeneration. He stressed the importance of selecting robust preclinical models, adopting multidimensional endpoints, and integrating biomarker-based strategies to enhance the translational value of neuropharmacological research. The session was highly engaging and stimulated thoughtful discussions among participants. Dr. Sarma's clarity, scientific depth, and practical perspectives provided valuable guidance for researchers working in stroke, epigenetics, and translational neuroscience.

Title: *Role of Substance-P Pathway in Neurological Disorders*

Resource Person: **Dr. Madhavan Nampoothiri G**, MCOPS, Manipal



The session delivered by Dr. Madhavan Nampoothiri provided a comprehensive and scientifically enriching overview of the **Substance-P (SP) and neurokinin (NK) system** and its expanding relevance in neurological disorders. He highlighted how dysregulation of the SP–NK1 receptor axis plays a crucial role in the progression of **Alzheimer’s disease**, particularly by modulating amyloidogenic processes, synaptic changes, and neurobehavioral outcomes. Dr. Madhavan further elaborated on the contribution of SP signaling to **neuroinflammation**, explaining how SP-mediated pathways enhance cytokine release, microglial activation, and downstream signaling cascades that drive chronic inflammation and neuronal vulnerability. An important aspect of the talk was the connection between **epigenetic regulation** and neurokinin pathways, where Dr. Madhavan described how epigenetic modifications may influence SP synthesis, receptor expression, and overall inflammatory tone within the CNS. This integrative perspective provided a deeper understanding of how molecular, cellular, and regulatory mechanisms converge to shape neurological pathology.

Participants found the session highly valuable, with Dr. Madhavan’s clarity, depth, and ability to translate complex mechanisms into meaningful insights greatly benefiting researchers and students. The session stimulated thoughtful discussions and enhanced the audience’s

understanding of the therapeutic potential of targeting the SP pathway in neuroinflammatory and neurodegenerative conditions.



Title: *Targeting Cancer and Cancer Stem Cells for Therapy*

Resource Person: **Dr. A. Rajanna**, National Institute of Nutrition (NIN), Hyderabad

The session delivered by Dr. A. Rajanna provided an in-depth and insightful overview of therapeutic strategies targeting **cancer and cancer stem cells (CSCs)**, with a particular focus on **brain tumors**. He explained the complex biology of brain cancers, emphasizing how tumor heterogeneity, invasive growth, and treatment resistance make them especially challenging to manage. Dr. Rajanna also discussed the influence of **epigenetic mechanisms** including DNA methylation and histone modifications in regulating CSC pathways and driving brain tumor aggressiveness. Dr. Rajanna visited **KLEF University** as part of this session and actively interacted with the delegates and pharmacy students. His discussions offered valuable guidance on research methodologies, and emerging therapeutic targets, which greatly benefited and motivated the student community.

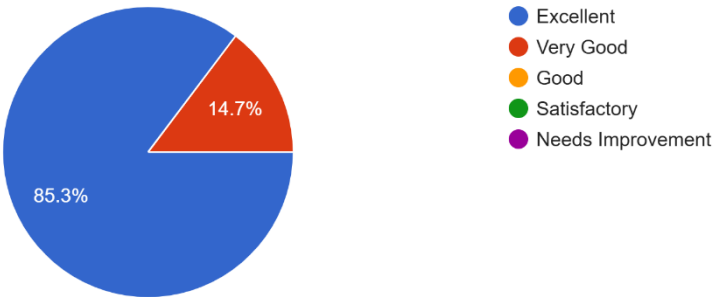

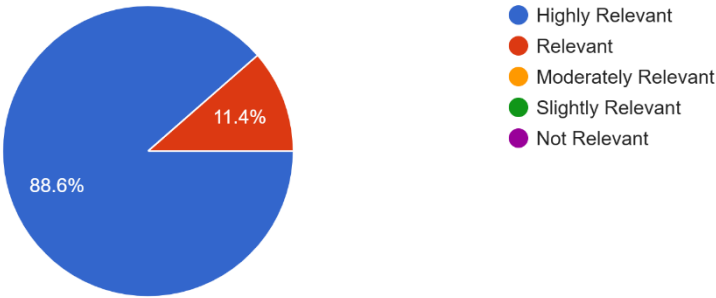

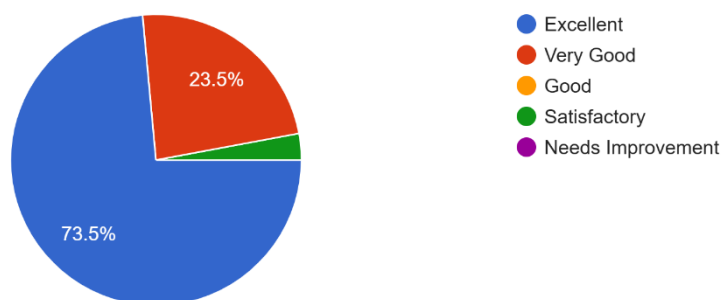

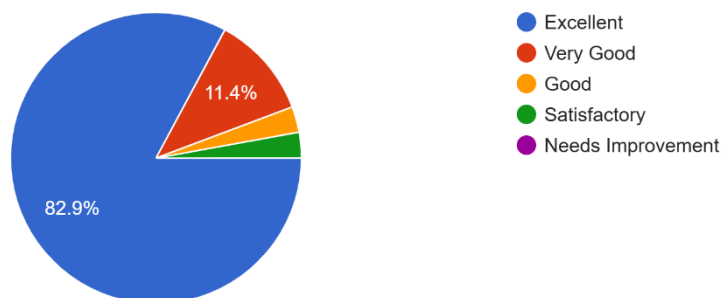

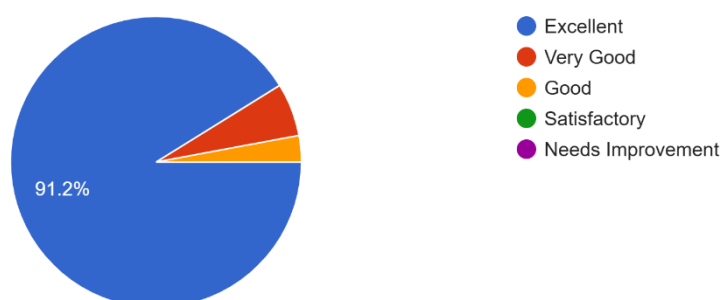

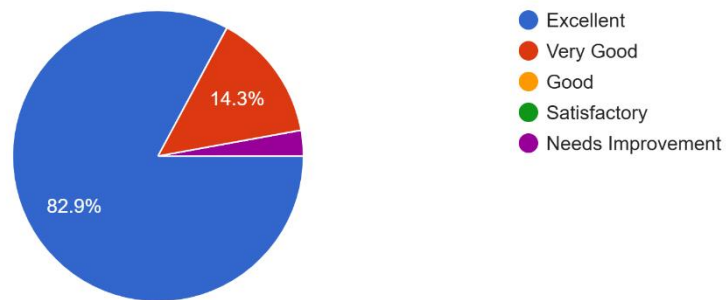
