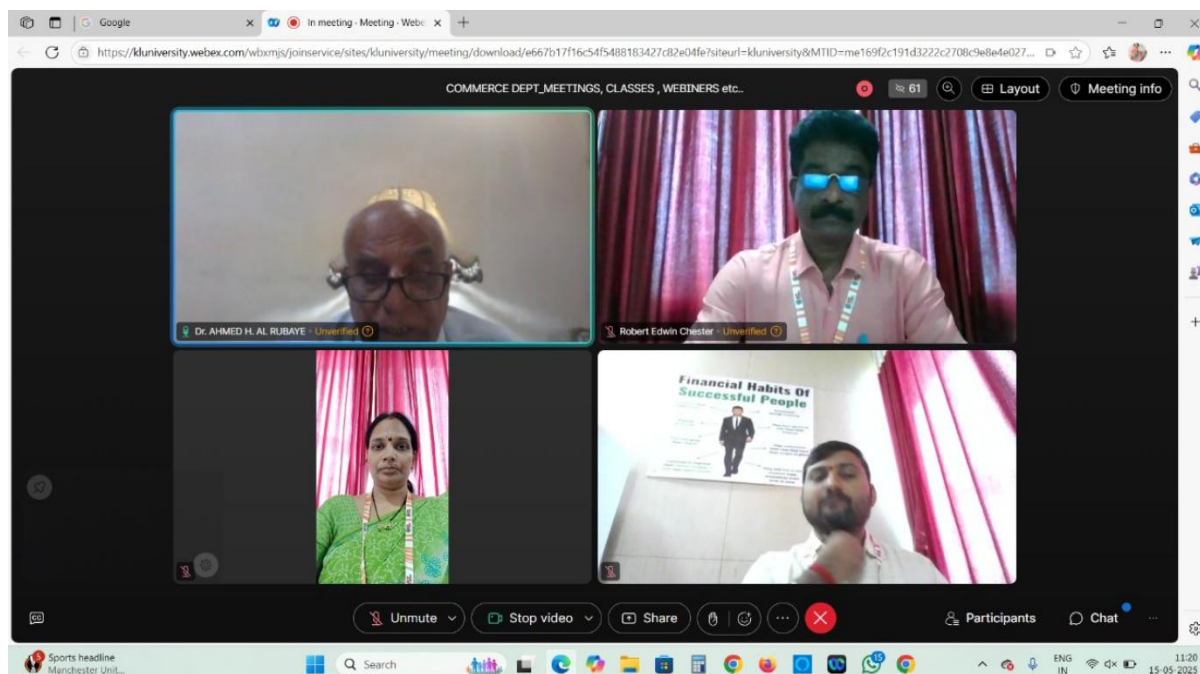
Commerce, warmly welcomed all the dignitaries, keynote speakers, faculty members, and participants from various universities and countries.



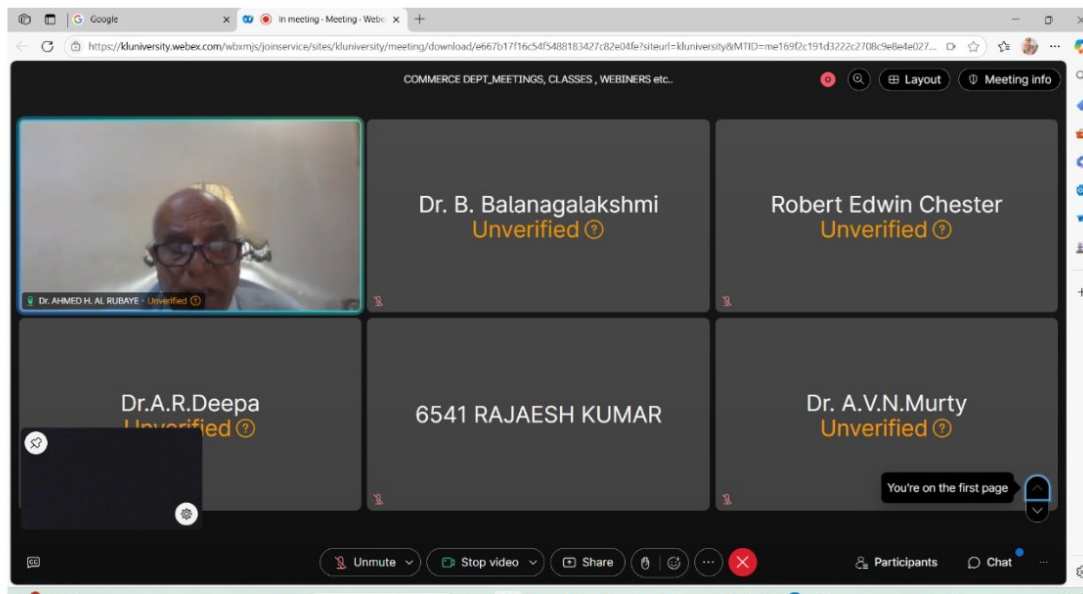

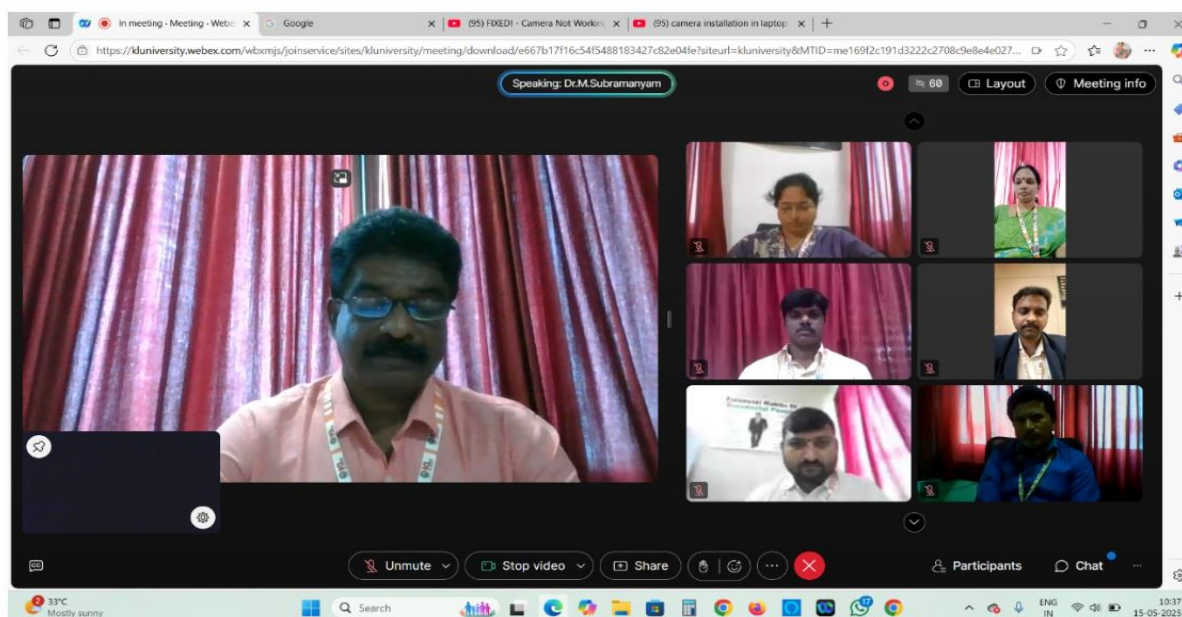
