Initiatives: Way Forward to Net Zero

KLEF’s campus has a potential of approximately 2.3 MW of solar energy, with plans to expand to 4 MW using available open space, reducing the campus carbon footprint. Green procurement procedures are being extended to energy-efficient utilities. All new constructions will follow Green Building specifications and aim for green building ratings. An intelligent monitoring system is being implemented to track real-time energy consumption. The university has set targets for renewable energy substitution by 2028, with a regular review mechanism to ensure roadmap progress.
