Fig.-1: Total Questions Option wise Student Average Count

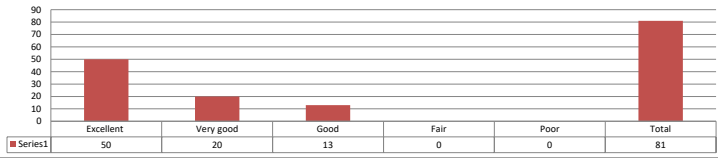


Fig.-2: Total Questions Option wise Student Average Percentage

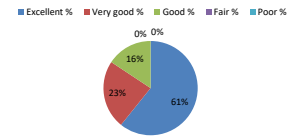


Fig.-3: Each question Options with Student Count

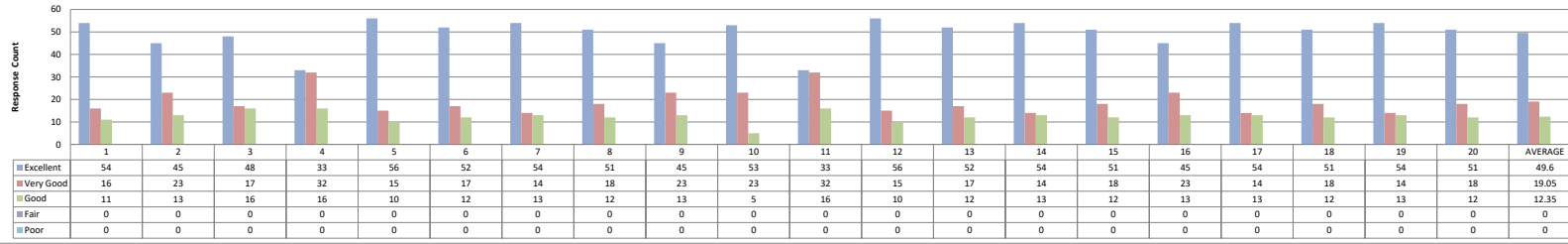


Fig.-4: Each question Options With Student Count Percentage

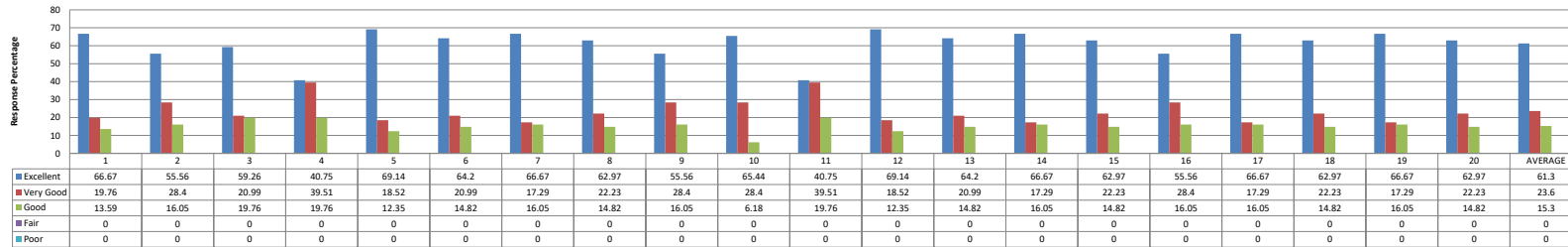


Fig.-5: Each question Options Student Count Percentage with Marks

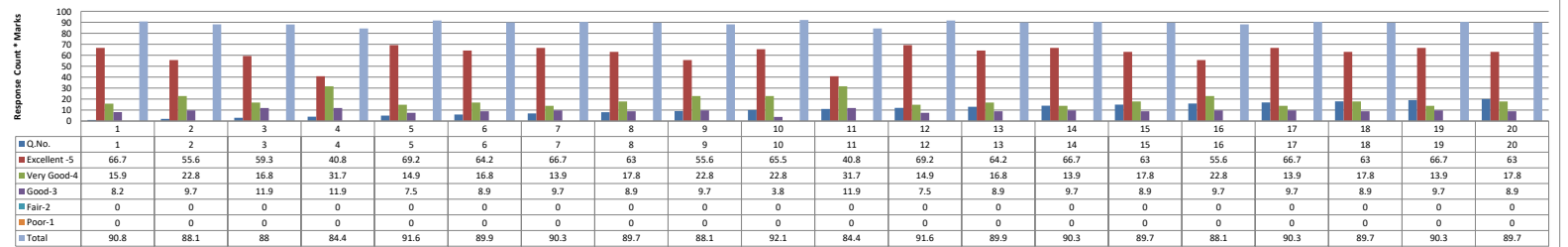
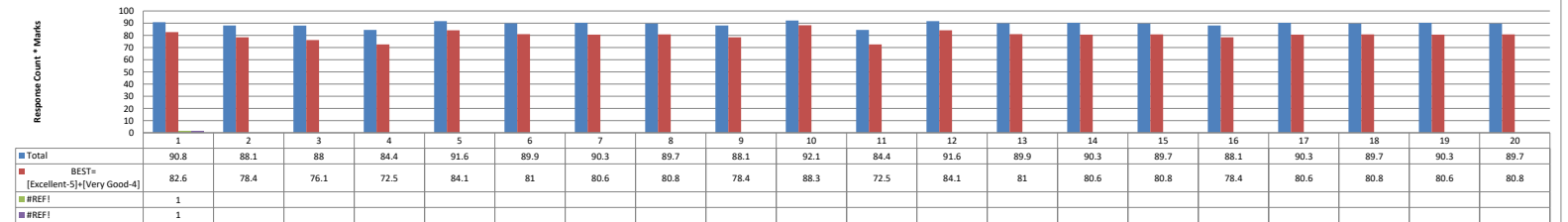
