


#### Day-1: 10-02-2025

The first session of day-1 was handled by Dr. B.T.P Madhav, Additional Dean (R&D), KLEF, which covered how faculty can improve their research papers, various tabs in research profile were clearly explained Research policy of the institute was also explained.

1. Enter Personal and Academic Information: Faculty members are required to enter their basic details (such as name, department, qualifications, research interests, etc.) in the system. This forms the basis of their academic profile.

**2. Add Research Projects:** The ERP system typically allows faculty to input details about their ongoing or completed research projects. This might include:

- Title of the project
- Project description
- Research objectives
- Collaborators (both internal and external)

**3.Document Publications:** Faculty can upload and maintain a record of their academic publications. This may include:

- Journal articles
- Conference papers
- Books or book chapters
- Other scholarly articles

The system may also allow integration with citation databases (e.g., IEEE, Scopus) to auto-fill citation counts and references.

**4.Update Patents, Innovations, and Research Impact:** Many ERP systems allow faculty to record patents or innovations resulting from their research. This section typically includes:

• Patent titles

- Inventor(s)
- Filing dates
- Patent numbers

Additionally, faculty members can track the impact of their research, including awards, recognitions, or media coverage.

#### **Conclusion:**



**Course Handouts**: Course handouts are essential materials for guiding students through the course. These documents help set expectations, provide additional reading, and outline key learning objectives.

- Course Outline: Overview of what will be covered, including the topics, dates, and structure.
- > Learning Objectives: Clearly state what students are expected to learn by the end of the course.
- > Reading Materials: A list of textbooks, articles, online resources, and any other required readings.

Assessment Methods: Information on assignments, exams, presentations, or projects, including grading rubrics.



Session was Continued by Dr. K. Uday Kiran, Assoc. Dean -Academics, KLEF. The **Problem Identification** phase in **Design Thinking** and **Innovation** is crucial as it sets the foundation for creating solutions that truly meet the needs of users. Here's a brief report purpose for this phase:

#### Purpose of Problem Identification in Design Thinking and Innovation

The primary purpose of **problem identification** is to **define and understand the core challenges** that users face. This phase ensures that the team is solving the **right problem**, rather than focusing on assumptions or superficial issues. The goals include:


- 1. **Understanding User Needs**: By identifying and empathizing with the users, you gather insights that highlight the real problems they encounter.
- 2. **Defining the Problem Clearly**: A well-defined problem helps to ensure that the solution is targeted and relevant, guiding the rest of the design process.
- 3. Aligning Stakeholders: It helps to align the team, stakeholders, and users on a common problem, ensuring everyone is working toward the same goal.
- 4. **Creating Opportunities for Innovation**: Clear identification of problems leads to more innovative and creative solutions, as it opens up opportunities to rethink current systems or products.
- 5. Fostering Empathy and Insight: The phase encourages empathy, ensuring that the solutions are human-centered, and based on genuine understanding rather than assumptions.

In summary, problem identification is about uncovering the **right problem** to solve and **aligning efforts** towards delivering the most impactful and innovative solutions that meet user needs.

This Session was Handled by Dr. M. V. Naresh, Associate Director, CDOE, KLEF. He explained the important aspects of the Objective Based Education, about Programme Educational Objectives (PEOs), Programme Outcomes (Pos), Graduate Attributes (GAs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Course Outcomes (Cos). He explained the Blooms Taxonomy and different levels such as Level I Remembering, Level2 Understanding, Level 3 Applying, Level 4 Analyng, Level 5 Evaluating and Level 6 Creating.

In an academic report, Bloom's Taxonomy can be used to describe how students engage with content at different cognitive levels. Here's a brief explanation for each level:

#### Level 1: Remembering

Students recall basic facts, definitions, and concepts relevant to the subject. For example, recalling historical dates or scientific formulas.

#### Level 2: Understanding

Students demonstrate comprehension by explaining concepts in their own words or summarizing key points. This helps assess whether they grasp the material beyond just memorizing it.

#### Level 3: Applying

Students use their knowledge to solve problems or apply theories in practical scenarios, showing their ability to implement learned concepts.

#### Level 4: Analyzing

Students break down information to understand its structure, relationships, and patterns, often involving comparison, categorization, or identifying causes and effects.

#### Level 5: Evaluating

Students assess ideas, arguments, or solutions based on certain criteria, providing reasoned judgments about their effectiveness or validity.

#### Level 6: Creating

At this level, students synthesize information to produce new ideas, theories, or solutions. They demonstrate higher-order thinking by combining knowledge in original ways.

**conclusion**, Bloom's Taxonomy provides a structured framework to guide the development of educational goals, assessments, and activities. By progressing through the levels—Remembering, Understanding, Applying, Analyzing, Evaluating, and Creating—students develop a deeper understanding and mastery of subjects. Using this taxonomy in academic settings ensures a comprehensive learning experience that challenges students to think at various cognitive levels.


