### Objectives:

The primary objective of the *Awareness Program on Pregnancy and Lactation, Immunization & Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD)* is to educate and empower the women of Vengalayapalem village regarding important health topics that directly impact their well-being and the well-being of their families. The program aims to provide comprehensive knowledge on proper healthcare during pregnancy and lactation, the significance of timely immunizations for children, and the preventive measures to reduce the risk of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD). By the end of the session, participants should be able to make informed health decisions, ensuring better health outcomes for themselves and their families.

### Description:

The program will be conducted in an outreach format in Vengalayapalem, Guntur district, with a focus on providing crucial health education to women in the community. It will cover three main health topics:

1. **Pregnancy and Lactation:** Participants will be educated on nutrition, common pregnancy-related complications, and proper care during the lactation period.
2. **Immunization:** The importance of childhood immunizations to prevent preventable diseases will be discussed, including guidance on vaccination schedules and the role of immunization in building immunity.
3. **Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD):** Information on CKD, its causes, risk factors, and preventive measures will be shared, including lifestyle changes that can help reduce the risk of kidney disease.

The program will be interactive, with opportunities for participants to ask questions and receive personalized health guidance. This initiative is designed to bridge the gap in healthcare awareness and support the community's long-term health and well-being.

4. **Stronger Community Engagement:** This outreach activity will strengthen the bond between the university and the local community, demonstrating the commitment of the Women's Forum to improving public health.
