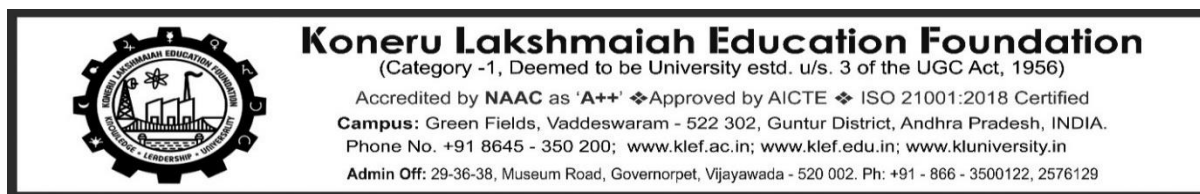

Session on “Various Government Funding Opportunities & Schemes Towards Startup Initiation

OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of the session on **“Various Government Funding Opportunities & Schemes Towards Startup Initiation”** was to enlighten students and teaching staff about the financial and developmental support provided by government bodies to foster entrepreneurship. The program aimed to demystify the processes involved in accessing government funding and schemes, enhance awareness of startup policies, and encourage participants to translate innovative ideas into viable business models by leveraging available resources.

DESCRIPTION

The session, organized by the Women’s Forum of KLEF, was conducted on 12th January 2024 at the KLEF Inhouse venue. It was attended by 67 participants, including students and teaching staff, under the guidance of faculty coordinator Mrs. Kanthimathi. The session featured detailed presentations on various government funding opportunities such as startup seed funds, innovation challenge programs, grants, and incubation schemes. It also emphasized the eligibility criteria, application procedures, and success stories of startups benefiting from these initiatives.

The session provided a platform for participants to gain insights into the entrepreneurial ecosystem and network with mentors and peers. Practical examples and live discussions were incorporated to encourage interactive learning. The event concluded with a Q&A session, allowing attendees to clarify doubts and explore personalized advice for their entrepreneurial aspirations.

OUTCOMES

The session successfully enhanced participants' understanding of government funding opportunities and schemes. It empowered attendees with practical knowledge of accessing startup resources, inspiring confidence to pursue entrepreneurial ventures.
