OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of organizing an awareness campaign on "Skin Care Post COVID" are to educate the community about the unique skin-related challenges and concerns that may arise in the aftermath of the pandemic. The Resource person Dr.Yasmeen Shaik completed Basic education cosmetic dental surgeon from NTR University and PG Diploma in Medical Cosmetology from Delhi and taken Fellowship in facial aesthetics and master course in micro pigmentation from Norwest university Georgia, and in Trichology from Mumbai and she told that During COVID, a lot of people get a small rash that is barely visible; that rash results in skin shedding . While recovering from COVID-19, many patients suffer from hair and skin-related issues like hair fall, acne, body pimples, skin peeling, and herpes among others. Is it normal to get skin peeling after COVID?

Does one need to take supplements to maintain skin and hair post COVID? If yes, which ones?

Some people have complained of severe hair fall, losing as much as 50 per cent of the hair, post-COVID. What is the reason and will hair regrow?
