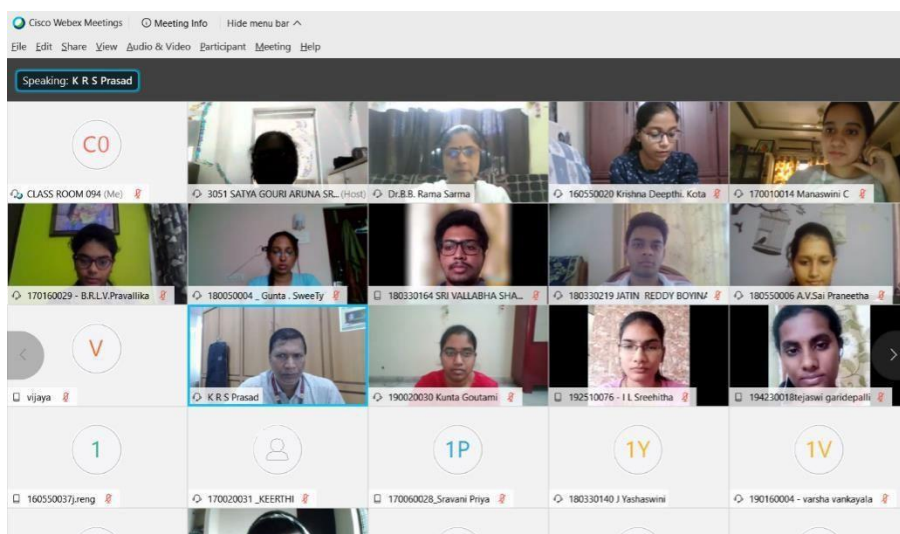

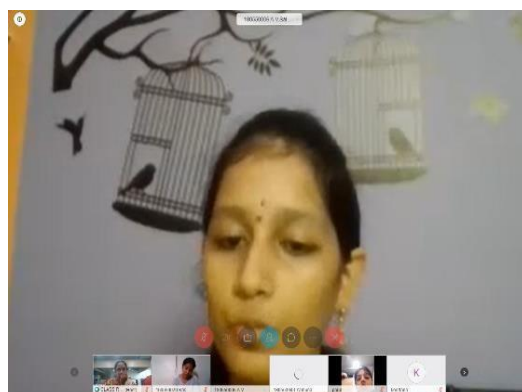
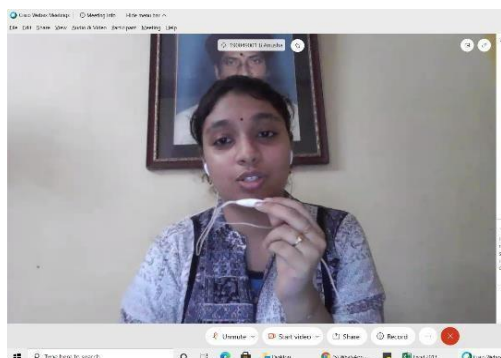
OUTCOMES
