#### **OBJECTIVES**

The primary objectives of organizing a workshop on cyber crimes for women and girls students are to empower them with essential knowledge and skills to protect themselves in the digital realm. This workshop aims to educate participants about the various forms of cybercrimes, including online harassment, identity theft, and cyber bullying, and equip them with strategies for online safety and responsible digital behavior. By raising awareness and enhancing digital literacy, the workshop seeks to reduce the vulnerability of women and girls to cybercrimes, promote their confidence in navigating the internet, and encourage them to become advocates for online security. Additionally, it aims to bridge the gender gap in cyber security knowledge, ultimately fostering a safer online environment and promoting gender equality in the digital space.

#### DESCRIPTION

The workshop on cybercrimes for women and girls students proved to be a highly informative and empowering event. This workshop is organized by KLEF Women Development Cell/ Women's Forum. Resource person to this workshop is Mr. Sai Satish, CEO Indian servers. The following aspects were discussed

Cyber crimes against women and children are on the raise and they have been drastically victimized in the cyberspace. Some illegal persons try to defame women and children by sending obscene e-mails, stalking women and children by using chat rooms, websites etc, developing pornographic videos where women and children are depicted in compromising positions mostly created without their consent, spoofing e-mails, morphing of images for pornographic content etc. Massive awareness needs to be created among women and children regarding the safe use of Mobile Phones, Computers and the Internet

How can women prevent cyber crime? The legal system has approved a variety of legislation to address cybercrime against women. Cyber Crime Prevention against Women & Children (CCPWC) scheme.

- 1. Spreading awareness about cyber crimes.
- 2. Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C)
- 3. National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal.

The primary purpose of a cyber awareness program is to educate people about possible cyber threats and avoid a data breach. However, no method can guarantee complete security from the attacks but can help reduce their occurrence and equip endusers and professionals with practical knowledge to mitigate such risks

#### **OUTCOMES**

The outcomes of organizing the workshop on cybercrimes for women and girls students have been profoundly positive. Participants emerged from the workshop with increased awareness of cyber threats and a heightened ability to protect themselves online, thereby reducing their vulnerability to cybercrimes.
