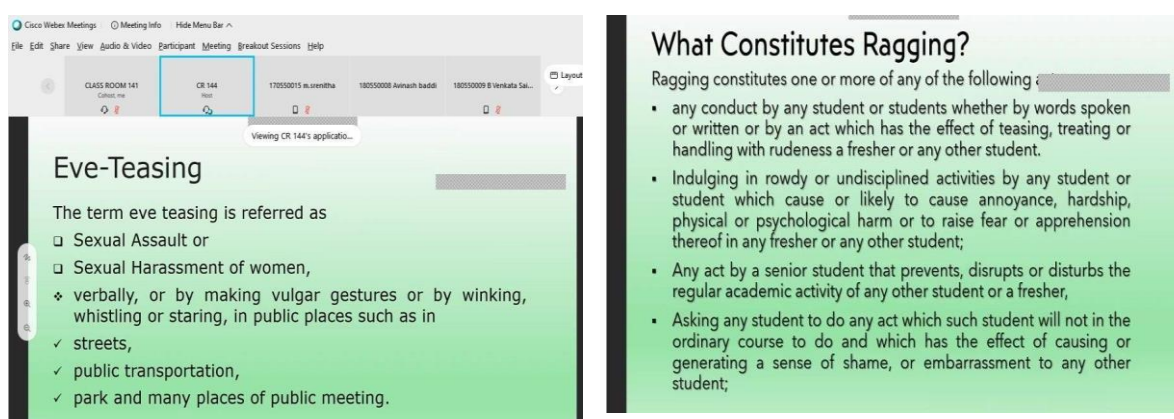

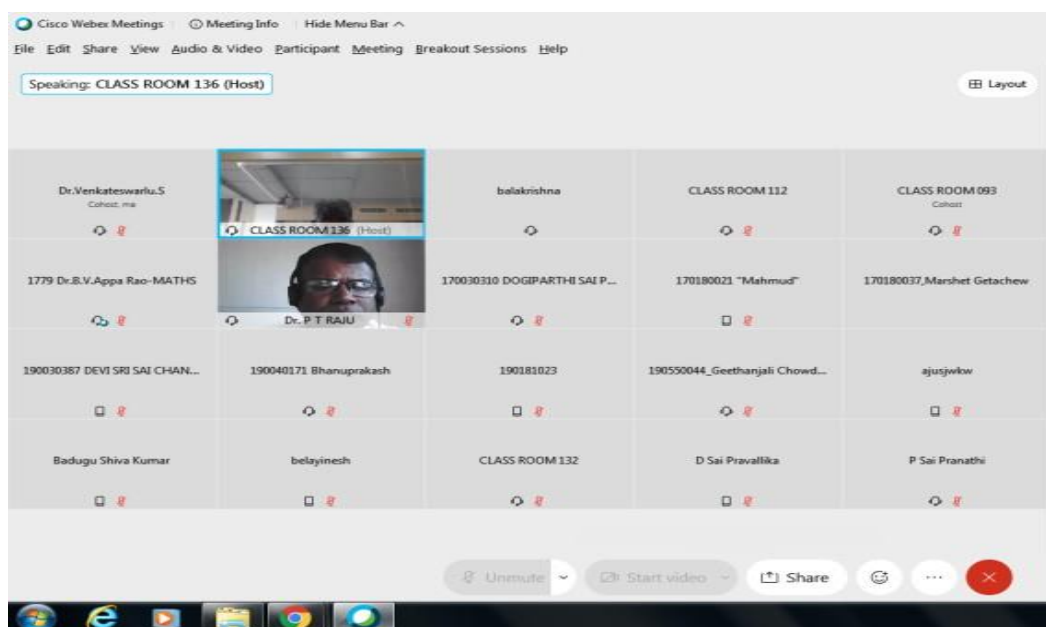
OUTCOMES:
