Objective:

The primary objective of the **Awareness Program on Infections & Malnutrition** was to educate the community about the causes, symptoms, prevention, and management of common infections while creating awareness about the impact of malnutrition on overall health. The program aimed to promote hygiene practices, proper nutrition, safe food habits, early identification of risk symptoms, and encourage utilisation of government health schemes.

Description:

The YRC volunteers from KL University organised an Awareness Program on Infections & Malnutrition at Chirravuru Village. Volunteers conducted door-to-door campaigns and interacted with villagers to educate them about infection prevention, sanitation, personal hygiene, nutrition, safe drinking water, and early signs of malnutrition.

Pamphlets and awareness materials were distributed on topics such as handwashing steps, prevention of infectious diseases, nutritious diet for children and adults, vaccination importance, and food safety practices.

Interactive group sessions were held where community members discussed their health concerns, dietary habits, and misconceptions. Health educators guided them on adopting better hygiene and nutritional practices.

Procedure of the Event:

The KLEF-YRC team reached Chirravuru by **10:00 AM**. The event began with a formal introduction explaining the purpose of the awareness program.

Volunteers were divided into groups and assigned different locations within the village.

Each group conducted awareness sessions on:

- Infection prevention and hygiene
- Safe water and sanitation practices
- Balanced diet
- Identification and management of malnutrition

- Awareness on Government healthcare and nutrition schemes (ICDS, mid-day meals, immunisation)

Pamphlets and informative leaflets were distributed to families.

Outcome of the event:

- The Awareness Program successfully reached approximately **350 villagers**.
- Participants actively interacted and showed interest in improving hygiene and dietary habits.
- The event increased community knowledge regarding infection prevention, nutrition improvement, and recognising symptoms of malnutrition.
- Families were encouraged to adopt healthy daily practices and seek timely medical care.
- The program strengthened the bond between the university volunteers and the local community.
- Beneficiaries appreciated the initiative and requested similar activities in the future.

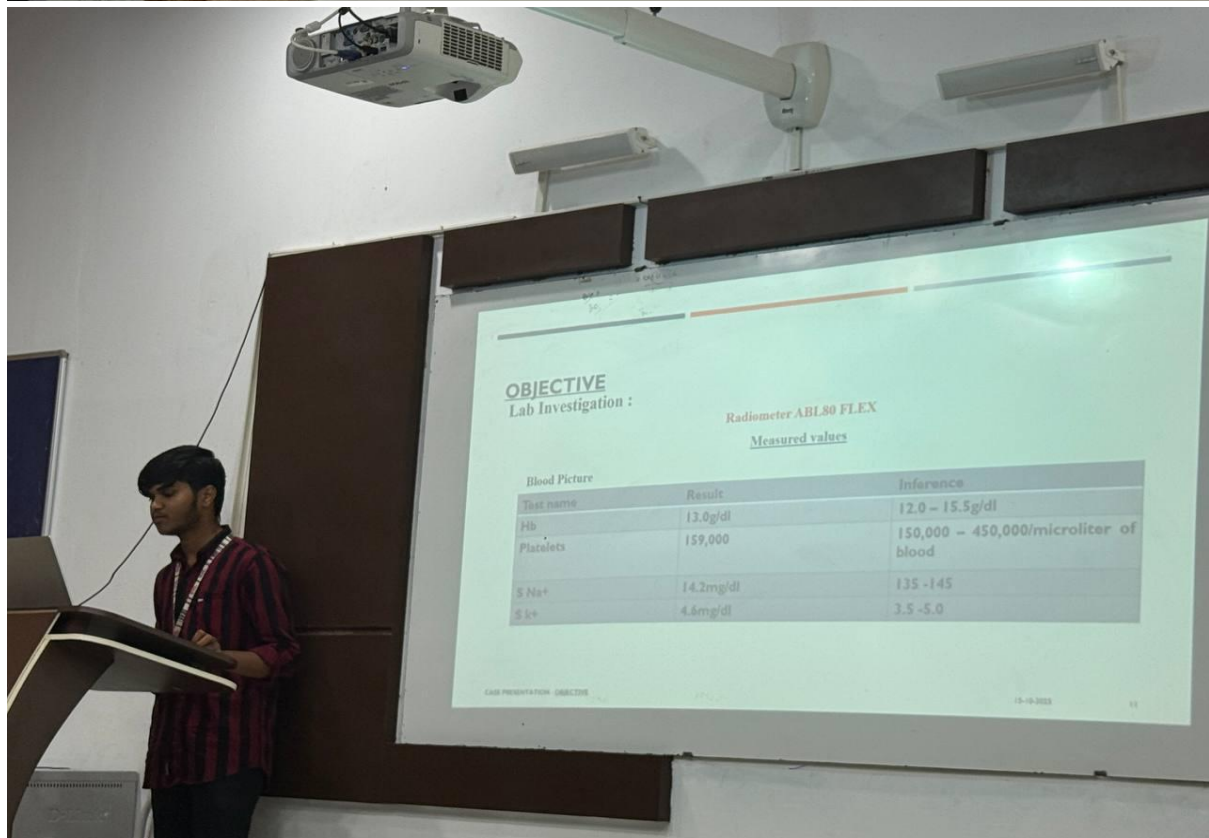
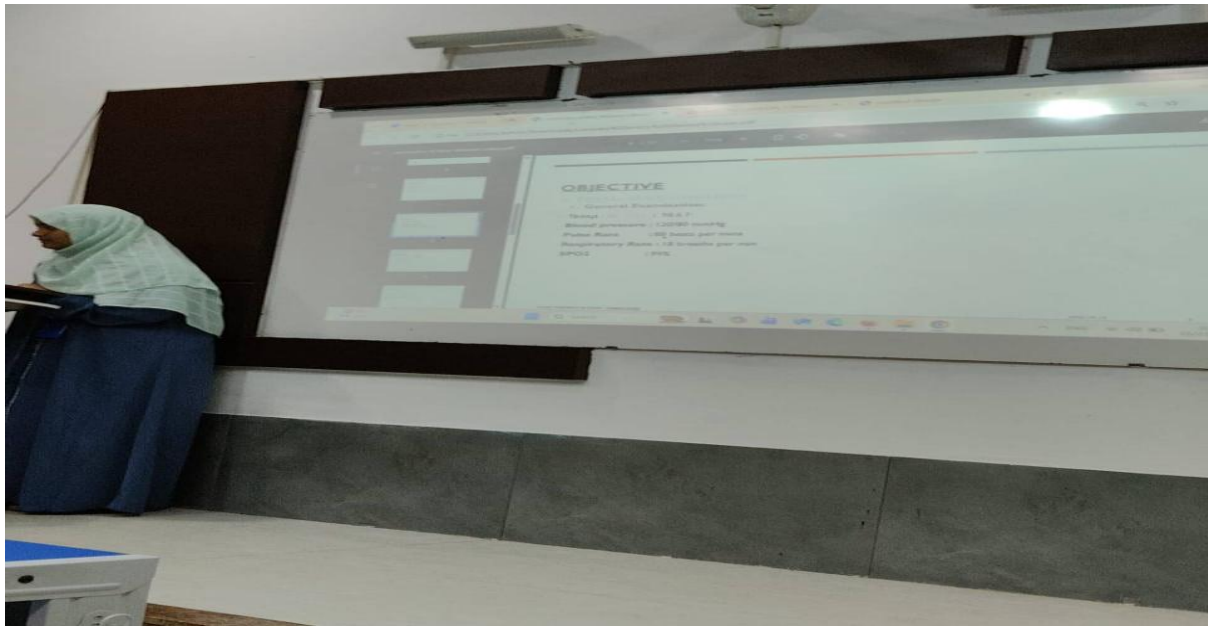
Outcome:

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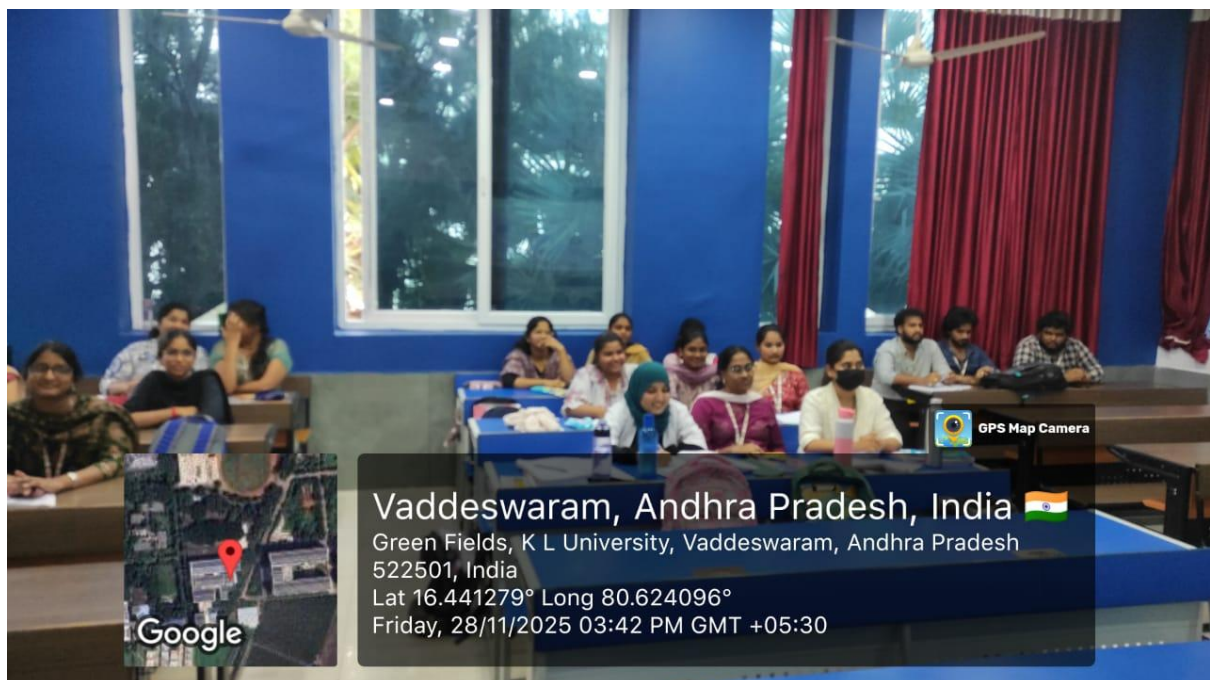
